# 1. Food Hygiene and Safety

# 2. Structure and Cleaning

The structure facilities and standard of cleaning and maintenance are all of a good standard and only minor repairs and/or improvements are required. Pest control and waste disposal provisions are adequate. The minor contraventions require your attention. (Score 5)

#### **Maintenance**

**Contravention** The following had not been suitably maintained and must be repaired or replaced:

• Damage to ceiling above area where vacuum packer is used. This was later attended to expeditely and new plaster and paintwork undertaken to rectify the damage.
