What you must do to comply with the law

Contraventions relating to structural repairs, your food safety management system and staff training, should be completed within the next 2 months.

Health and safety contraventions should be dealt with within 3 months unless otherwise stated.

1. Food Hygiene and Safety

Food hygiene standards are high. You demonstrated a very good standard of compliance with legal requirements. You have safe food handling practices and procedures and all the necessary control measures to prevent cross-contamination are in place. Some minor contraventions require your attention. **(Score 5)**

Contamination risks

Contravention The following exposed food to the general risk of cross-contamination with bacteria or allergens or its physical contamination with dirt, foreign objects or chemicals:

- an insectocutor was sited above a food preparation table in main bakery production room

Hand-washing

Observation I was pleased to see hand washing was well managed.

Personal Hygiene

Observation I was pleased to see that standards of personal hygiene were high.

2. Structure and Cleaning

The structure facilities and standard of cleaning and maintenance are of a generally satisfactory standard but there are some repairs and/or improvements which are required in order for you to comply with the law. Pest control and waste disposal provisions are adequate. The contraventions require your attention; although not critical to food safety they may become so if not addressed. **(Score 10)**

Cleaning of Structure

Contravention The following items were dirty and require more frequent and thorough cleaning:

- around equipment feet
- floor/wall junctions
- high level cleaning

Contravention The following items could not be effectively cleaned and must be covered, sealed, repaired, made non-absorbent or replaced:

- rust to base of racking used to store dry goods in main bakery production area.

Maintenance

Contravention The following had not been suitably maintained and must be repaired or replaced:

- floor surfaces worn/damaged
- hole to ceiling near rear staff kitchen entrance
- damaged hinge to sandwich makeup chiller.
- damaged plastic storage containers in rear bread slicing room used to store redundant baking tins

Pest Control

Contravention Pest proofing is inadequate particularly in the following areas:

- holes in the internal wall cladding
- the external main metal framed front double doors. This was raised by the inspector at the last inspection.

Observation You have a pest control contract in place and there is no recent evidence of pest activity on the premises.

3. Confidence in Management

A food safety management system is in place and you demonstrate a very good standard of compliance with the law. You have a good track record. There are some minor contraventions which require your attention. Your staff are suitably supervised and trained.

Your records are appropriate and generally maintained. You have a good track record. There are some minor contraventions which require your attention. **(Score 5)**

Proving Your Arrangements are Working Well

Contravention The following matters are needed in order to demonstrate your food safety management system is working as it should:

- several omissions of cooked core food temperatures on your record sheets.
