### 1. Food Hygiene and Safety

Food hygiene standards are high. You demonstrated a very good standard of compliance with legal requirements. ## **2. Structure and Cleaning**

The structure facilities and standard of cleaning and maintenance are all of a good standard and only minor repairs and/or improvements are required. Pest control and waste disposal provisions are adequate. The minor contraventions require your attention. **(Score 5)**

### **Cleaning of Structure**

**Contravention** The following items were dirty and require more frequent and thorough cleaning:

- wash hand basin

### **Maintenance**

**Contravention** The following had not been suitably maintained and must be repaired or replaced:

- wall surfaces damaged in places

### **Facilities and Structural provision**

**Contravention** The following facilities were inadequate and must be improved:

- insufficient storage space

### **Pest Control**

**Observation** I was pleased to see that the premises was proofed against the entry of pests and that pest control procedures were in place.

## **3. Confidence in Management**

A food safety management system is in place and you demonstrate a very good standard of compliance with the law. You have a good track record. There are some minor contraventions which require your attention. **(Score 5)**

### **Type of Food Safety Management System Required**

**Observation** Your SFBB/food safety management system was in place and generally working well. I was confident you had effective control over hazards to food.

**Recommendation** Add a section to your FSMS that covers the tasting sessions.

**Contravention** The following pre-requisites have not been met and prove your food safety management system is ineffective in places: storage space is inadequate.

### Traceability

**Observation** Your records were such that products could easily be traced back to its supplier.

### Infection Control / Sickness / Exclusion Policy

**Guidance** UK Health Security Agency recommends that food handlers known or suspected to be suffering from a food-borne infection or gastrointestinal illness stay away from work until symptom-free for 48 hours.

### Waste Food and other Refuse

**Observation** You had measures in place to dispose of waste food appropriately.

### Allergens

**Observation** All pre-packed and labelled.
