

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (CTRO1370) affecting the Christchurch Road from its junction with Unthank Road to its junction with Grange Road ("Road A") and Christchurch Road from its junction with Unthank Road to its junction with The Plantation ("Road B") and Unthank Road from its junction with Beechbank for 220 metres south-westwards ("Road C") in the City of Norwich to facilitate traffic signal upgrade and pedestrian crossing installation works, the Roads A, B and C will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access) and traffic (constituting any class of vehicle) over the Roads A and B shall be temporarily prohibited to park, stop, load, and/or unload for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be from 12<sup>th</sup> January to 20<sup>th</sup> February 2026, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 20<sup>th</sup> August 2026 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

**NB: Please note that Road A and Road B will be closed and restricted from 12<sup>th</sup> January to 20<sup>th</sup> February. Road C will be closed from 18<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> February.**

**NB: The parking restriction on Road A and B applies to both sides of the carriageway.**

Alternative route is via: **A)** Unthank Road, Colman Road, Jessopp Road, Christchurch Road and vice versa **B)** Unthank Road, Mile End Road, Newmarket Road, Christchurch Road and vice versa **C)** Unthank Road, Earlham Road, Colman Road and vice versa.

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Norfolk County Council.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Roads A-C where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works/when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 20<sup>th</sup> August 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
