TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDERS 2026 (NORWICH)
Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984

Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby give notice that:

(i) THEY PROPOSE TO MAKE Temporary Traffic Regulation Orders in respect of the following roads:

ALL SAINTS GREEN – A) All Saints Green from its junction with Queens Road to its junction with Winalls Yard and **B) All Saints Green** from its junction with Surrey Street to its junction with Winalls Yard and **C) All Saints Green (northwest side of the carriageway)** from 10m northeast of its junction with Surrey Street for 15m north-eastwards and **D) Queens Road** from 50m southeast of its junction with Queens Road/ Chapelfield Roundabout for 67m south-eastwards and **E) Queens Road (northeast side of the carriageway)** from 50m southeast of its junction with Queens Road/ Chapelfield Roundabout for 37m south-eastwards and **F) Surrey Street (northeast side of the carriageway)** from 5m northwest of its junction with Surrey Grove for 10m north-westwards and **G) Bull Lane** from its junction with Queens Road to its junction with All Saints Green and **H) St Stephens Street** at its junction with Surrey Street to facilitate gas main replacement works. The Roads A, B and G will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access), traffic over Roads C, E and F will be temporarily prohibited to park, stop, load, and/or unload and Road H shall be temporarily subject to the suspension of a no right turn restriction allowing traffic (buses, cyclists and taxis) to turn right onto Surrey Street for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be from 29th January to 27th February 2026 (may continue until 27th August 2026). Alternative route is via: **A) Queens Road, Surrey Street and vice versa B) Surrey Street, Queens Road, Queens Road/ Chapel Field Road Roundabout, Queens Road and vice versa C, D, E, F, G, H) N/A.** The works promoter is Cadent. **NB: Please note that Road A and Road B will not be closed at the same time.**

(ii) THEY HAVE MADE Temporary Traffic Regulation Orders in respect of the following roads:

PEVERELL ROAD - from its junction with Skoner Road to its junction with Smeat Street to facilitate investigation and repair of carriageway depression from 19th January to 22nd January 2026 (may continue until 5th March 2026). Alternative route is via: Peverell Road, Clover Hill Road, Humbleyard and vice versa. The works promoter is Norfolk County Council.

ST FAITHS LANE FOOTWAY – (east side of the carriageway) from its joining with Prince of Wales Road for 20m northwards to facilitate gas main upgrade works from 19th to 30th January 2026 (may continue until 13th March 2026). Alternative route is via: St Faiths Lane, Recorder Road, Prince Of Wales Road and vice versa. The works promoter is Cadent.

SWANSEA ROAD - from its junction with Denbigh Road for 30m southwards to facilitate new water connection works from 19th to 21st January 2026 (may continue until 4th March 2026). Alternative route is via: Denbigh Road, Cardiff Road, Avenue Road, Swansea Road and vice versa. The works promoter is Anglian Water.

Unless otherwise stated, the effect of these Orders will be to prohibit the use by vehicles of the named road(s)/ footpath(s). In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance. Where an Order is for a reason other than works it is because of the likelihood of danger to the public or of serious damage to the road/footpath. **Anticipated dates are stated but the Orders may continue until the end date where necessary or required.** The Orders are revoked on the end date or on the actual date of removal of the prohibition/restriction where earlier without further

notice. If necessary, the restrictions can have a maximum duration of 18 months or 6 months in respect of footpaths, cycle paths, bridleways, restricted byways, and byways open to all traffic (BOAT).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
