

**Norfolk County Council (Norwich, Carrow Road and Thorpe Road)
Emergency Notice
Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026
Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

Norwich, Carrow Road and Thorpe Road (CTRO1481) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to a dangerous defect the use by vehicles (of any class) of Carrow Road from its junction with Barton Way to its junction with Wilson Road (the "Road A"), Carrow Road from its junction with Lower Thorpe Road to its junction with Clarence Road (the "Road B"), Thorpe Road from its junction with Carrow Road to its junction with Clarence Road (the "Road C"), Thorpe Road from its junction with Lower Clarence Road to its junction with Riverside (the "Road D"), and Thorpe Road from its junction with Cotman Road to its junction with Carrow Road (the "Road E") in the City of Norwich will be temporarily prohibited/restricted as follows:

Road A – shall be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access).

Road B – shall be temporarily subject to the suspension of the one-way system (southwest bound) to allow vehicles to travel in both a northeast and southwest direction.

Road C – shall be temporarily subject to the suspension of the bus gate to allow vehicles to travel along the Road C.

Road D – shall be temporarily subject to the suspension of the bus gate to allow vehicles to travel along the Road D.

Road E – shall be temporarily restricted from turning right onto Carrow Road.

Alternative route is via: **Diversion 1** - Thorpe Road, Riverside, Koblenz Avenue, Canary Way, Carrow Road and **Diversion 2** - No right turn diversion – Thorpe Road, Yarmouth Road, Northside Roundabout, Yarmouth Road, Thorpe Road.

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Anglian Water.

The closure and restrictions are necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public or serious damage to the road or both.

The closure and restrictions are anticipated to take place from 20th to 26th February 2026 but the Roads A-E may continue to be closed/restricted until the 12th March 2026 where the closure and restrictions are still required beyond the anticipated dates.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works / when the closure and restrictions are no longer necessary or otherwise on the 12th March 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for an additional 21 days by further Notice and/or for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by further Order.

The relevant parts of any existing Orders made under the RTRA 1984 will become suspended where they conflict with the provisions of this Notice during the operation of this Notice.

Carrow Road and Thorpe Road CTRO1481 Emergency Notice (various restrictions)


A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/ closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.






Road A
