

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (CTRO1441) affecting the St Giles Street from 70 metres east of its junction with Willow Lane to its junction with Fishers Lane ("Road A") and St Giles Street from its junction with Fishers Lane to its junction with St Peters Street ("Road B") in the City of Norwich to facilitate lead communication pipe replacement works, the Road A will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access) and Road B shall be temporarily subject to the suspension of the one-way system (eastbound) to allow vehicles to travel in both a easterly and westerly direction for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be between 18:00 and 07:00 from 9<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> February 2026, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 27<sup>th</sup> March 2026 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

**NB: Please note that the closure/restriction will be in place for one night during the anticipated dates period.**

Alternative route is via: **A) Bethel Street, St Peters Street and St Giles Street.**

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Anglian Water.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Roads A and B where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works/when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 27<sup>th</sup> March 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.


In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
