

**Norfolk County Council (Norwich, St Stephens Street and Surrey Street)**  
**Urgent Notice**  
**Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026**  
**Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

Norwich, St Stephens Street and Surrey Street (CTRO1408a) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to gas main replacement works the existing prohibition of motor vehicles (excluding buses and taxis) on St Stephens Street (south-west bound) from its junction with Surrey Street to its junction with Chapelfield Roundabout ("Road A") will be temporarily suspended to allow all types of vehicular traffic to travel south-west bound on Road A and exit onto Chapelfield Roundabout and the existing prohibition of motor vehicles (excluding buses and taxis) on Surrey Street from its junction with All Saints Green to its junction with St Stephens Street ("Road B") will be temporarily suspended to allow all types of vehicular traffic to travel northbound on Road B in the City of Norwich.

Alternative route is via: N/A.

The works promoter for this restriction is: Cadent.

This restriction is necessary or expedient because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the Road.

The restriction is anticipated to take place from 23<sup>rd</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> February 2026.

This Notice shall be in effect from 23<sup>rd</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> February 2026 or until the restriction is no longer necessary, whichever is the earliest.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 27<sup>th</sup> February 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by an Order.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.


Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

The relevant parts of any existing Orders made under the RTRA 1984 will become suspended where they conflict with the provisions of this Notice during the operation of this Notice.
