Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Sections 14(1) and 15(3)

Notice (CTRO1411)

Notice is given that the Secretary of State for Transport has approved the continuing in force for the period set out below of an Order made by the Norfolk County Council under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, prohibiting the use by the public of St Faiths Lane Footway (east side of the carriageway) from its joining with Prince of Wales Road for 20 metres northwards in the City of Norwich owing to gas main upgrade works by Cadent.

Date of Original Order: 16th January 2026.

Previous restriction period: 19th January to 13th March 2026.

Period of extension: 14th to 27th March 2026.


Alternative route is via: St Faiths Lane, Recorder Road, Prince of Wales Road and vice versa.

Persons who contravene the Order will be liable, on conviction, to a fine.
