

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (CTRO1461) affecting the Cambridge Street from its junction with Trinity Street to its junction with Rupert Street ("Road A") and Cambridge Street from its junction with Trinity Street to its junction with Rupert Street ("Road B") and Cambridge Street from its junction with Unthank Road to its junction with Rupert Street ("Road C") and Cambridge Street from its junction with Unthank Road to its junction with Rupert Street ("Road D") and Cambridge Street from its junction with Unthank Road to its junction with Trinity Street ("Road E") in the City of Norwich to facilitate carriageway patching, drainage repairs and footway works. The Road A will be temporarily closed/restricted (except for pedestrian access); traffic (constituting any class of vehicle) over the Road B shall be temporarily subject to the suspension of the one-way system (westbound) to allow vehicles to travel in both an easterly and westerly direction; the Road C will be temporarily closed/restricted (except for pedestrian access); traffic (constituting any class of vehicle) over the Road D shall be temporarily subject to the suspension of the one-way system (eastbound) to allow vehicles to travel in both an easterly and westerly direction; and traffic (constituting any class of vehicle) over the Road E shall be temporarily prohibited to park, stop, load, and/or unload for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be between 09:00 and 16:00 from 9th to 13th March 2026, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 24th April 2026 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

NB: please note that the works will be carried out in two phases within the anticipated dates period. These phases will not be in place at the same time. Phase 1 consists of the restrictions over the Road A, Road B and Road E. Phase 2 consists of the restrictions over the Road C, Road D and Road E.

Alternative route is via: Road A: Brunswick Street, Union Street, Walpole Street, Vauxhall Street, Chapel Field Road, Convent Road, Unthank Road and Cambridge Street; Road C: Unthank Road, Convent Road, Chapel Field Road, St Stephens Road, Newmarket Road, Brunswick Road and Cambridge Street.

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Norfolk County Council.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Roads A–E where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works/when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 24th April 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.


Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.



In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
