

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (CTRO1485b) affecting the Prince of Wales Road Cycle Way (south side of carriageway only) from 70 metres northwest of its junction with St Vedast Street for 50 metres north-westwards (the "Cycle Way") in the City of Norwich to facilitate gas pipe repair works. The Cycle Way will be temporarily closed/restricted for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be from 8<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> April 2026, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2026 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

**NB: Please note that the works will take place for 24 hours within the anticipated dates period.**

Alternative route is via: N/A. Cyclists are asked to dismount.

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Cadent.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works/when the closure/restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 6 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses the Cycle Way in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

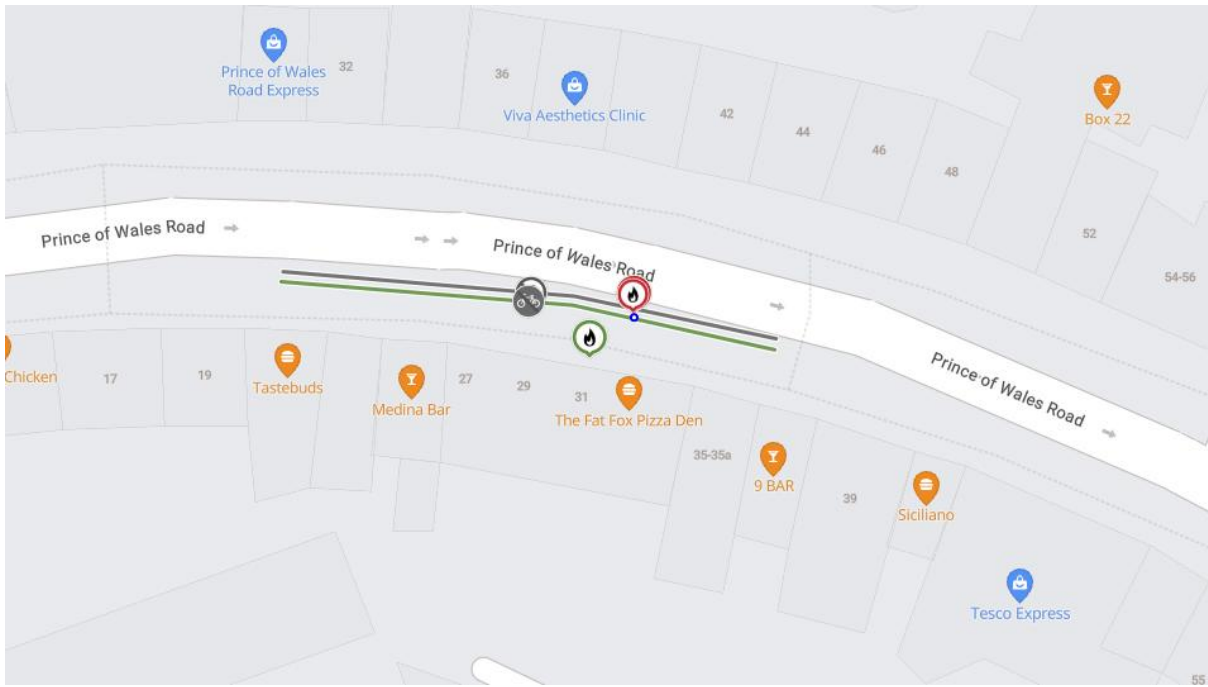
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
