

**Norfolk County Council (Norwich, Carrow Hill)**  
**Emergency Continuation Notice**  
**Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026**  
**Section 14(2) and 15(8)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

Norwich, Carrow Hill (CTRO1496) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) and 15(8)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereafter "RTRA 1984"), the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to sinkhole investigation and repairs the use by vehicles (of any class) of Carrow Hill from its junction with King Street to its junction with Bracondale (the "Road") in the City of Norwich will be continue to be temporarily prohibited/restricted.

The closure/restriction is necessary because of the likelihood or danger to the public or serious damage to the road or both.

The closure/restriction is anticipated to take place from 29th March to 18<sup>th</sup> April 2026 (previously 9<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> March 2026).

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum of 18 months from the date the first Notice was effective by further Order.

Any existing restrictions or prohibitions within Orders made under the RTRA 1984 will become suspended where they conflict with the provisions of this Notice during the operation of this Notice.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works / when the closure/restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 18<sup>th</sup> April 2026 without further notice.

Alternative route is via: King Street, Bracondale.

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Norfolk County Council.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/ closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

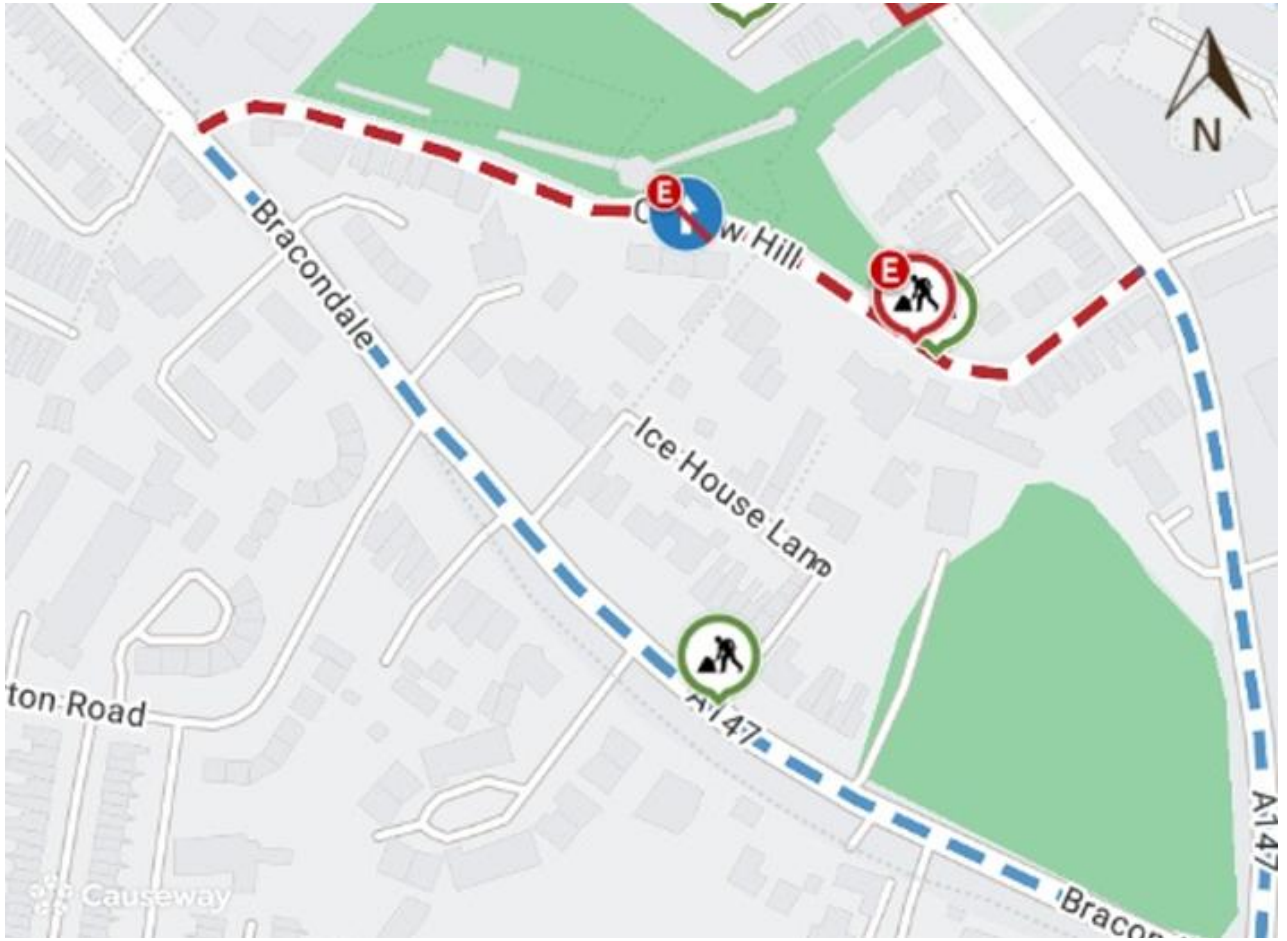
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
