

**Norfolk County Council (Norwich, St Faiths Lane)**  
**Emergency Notice**  
**Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026**  
**Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

Norwich, St Faiths Lane (CTRO1482) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to an emergency gas main replacement the use by vehicles (of any class) of the St Faiths Lane from 1 metre south of its junction with Recorder Road to 1 metre north of its junction with Stuart Gardens (the "Road") in the City of Norwich will be temporarily prohibited/restricted only whilst signs indicate closures are in place.

Alternative route is via: N/A.

N.B. workers will allow access to premises and business as required during working hours at all other times road will be open and road plates over excavations.

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Cadent.

The closure/restriction is necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public or serious damage to the road or both.

The closure/restriction is anticipated to take place between 07:00 and 18:00 from 12<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> March 2026 but the Road may continue to be closed/restricted until the 1<sup>st</sup> April 2026 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works / when the closure/restriction is no longer necessary.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for an additional 21 days by further Notice and/or for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by further Order.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/ closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.


