

**Norfolk County Council (Norwich, Union Street)**  
**Emergency Notice**  
**Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026**  
**Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

Norwich, Union Street (CTRO1498) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to a gas escape the use by vehicles (of any class) of the Union Street from 15 metres south-west of its junction with Norfolk Street for 30 metres north-eastwards (the "Road") in the City of Norwich will be temporarily prohibited/restricted.

Alternative route is via: Union Street, Walpole Street, Vauxhall Street, Chapel Field Road, St Stephens Roundabout, St Stephens Road, Newmarket Road, Brunswick Road and vice versa. Alternative route for Norfolk Street is via: Norfolk Street, Vauxhall Street, Walpole Street and Union Street or to pick up above diversion if heading to southwest of Union Street closure.

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Cadent.

The closure/restriction is necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public or serious damage to the road or both.

The closure/restriction is anticipated to take place from 9<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> March 2026 but the Road may continue to be closed/restricted until the 29<sup>th</sup> March 2026 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works / when the closure/restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 29<sup>th</sup> March 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for an additional 21 days by further Notice and/or for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by further Order.

Any existing [restrictions or prohibitions within] Orders made under the RTRA 1984 will become suspended where they conflict with the provisions of this Notice during the operation of this Notice.



A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/ closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
