The proposal is to extent the premium food led operation showcasing premium quality alcohol and non-alcoholic drinks. With the inclusion of social gaming (darts and shuffleboard) as a bookable experience to the existing offer. The space and customer experience will be managed by us, as the operators (Yalm Limited) we will have full control over all operations, Including all front of house management. staff training and service standards.






