Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026
Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Norwich, Bracondale (CTRO1545) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to gas escape repairs the use by vehicles (of any class) of the Bracondale (south-east bound lane) from its junction with King Street to its junction with the Bracondale/Martineau Lane Roundabout (the "Road") in the City of Norwich will be temporarily prohibited.

Alternative route from King Street is via: King Street, Bracondale, Queens Road, St Stephens Roundabout, St Stephens Road, Ipswich Road, Lakenham Road, Hall Road, Barrett Road, Martineau Lane.

Alternative route from Bracondale Southbound is via: King Street, Carrow Road, Koblenz Avenue, Riverside, Riverside Road, Bishop Bridge Road, Barrack Street, St Crispins Road, Barn Road, Grapes Hill, Chapel Field Road, St Stephens Road, Ipswich Road, Lakenham Road, Barrett Street and Martineau Lane.

The works promoter for this closure is: Cadent.

The closure is necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public or serious damage to the Road or both.

The closure is anticipated to take place from 23rd to 29th April 2026 but the Road may continue to be closed until the 13th May 2026 where the closure is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works / when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 13th May 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for an additional 21 days by further Notice and/or for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by further Order.

Any existing restrictions or prohibitions within Orders made under the RTRA 1984 will become suspended where they conflict with the provisions of this Notice during the operation of this Notice.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

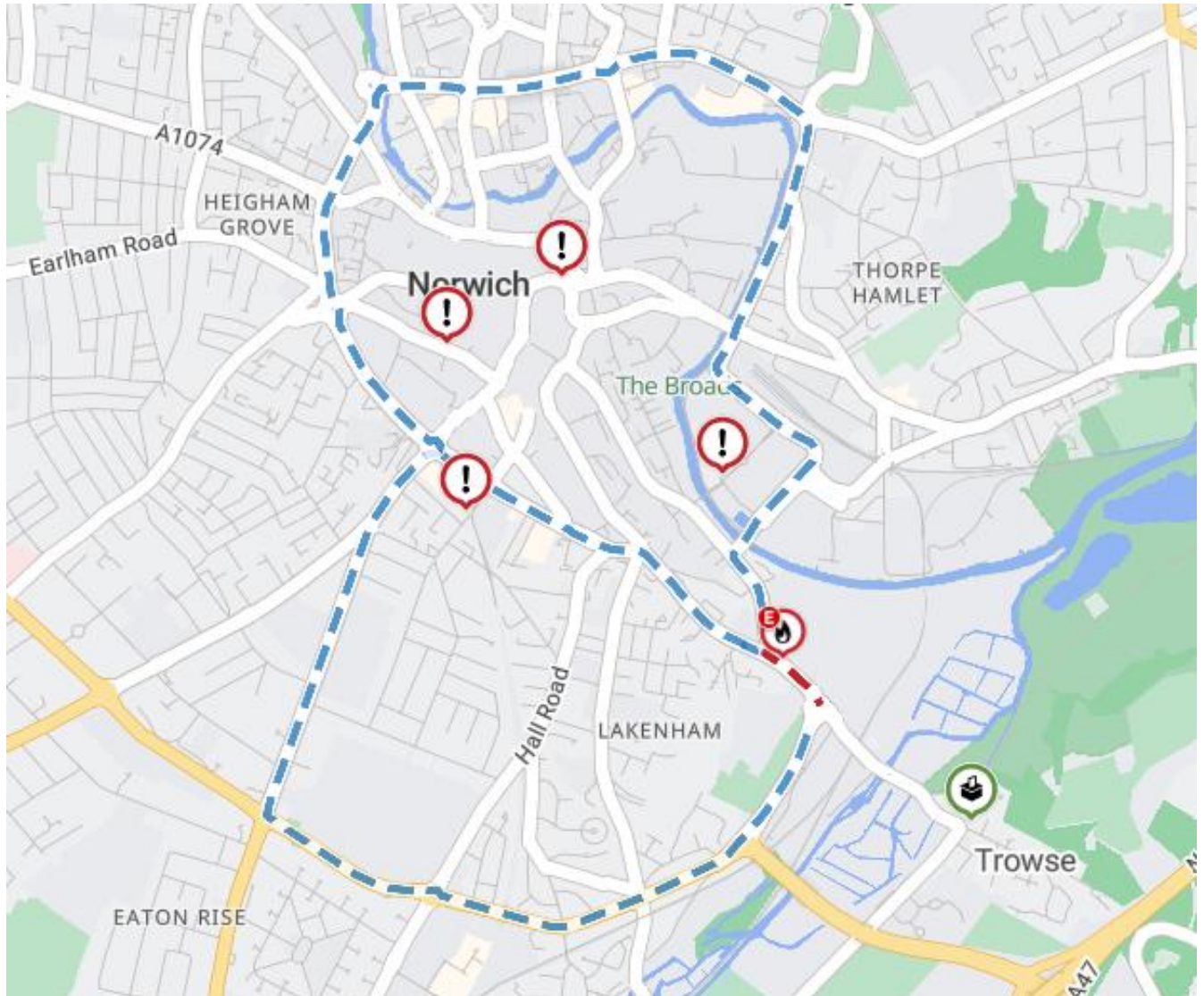
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

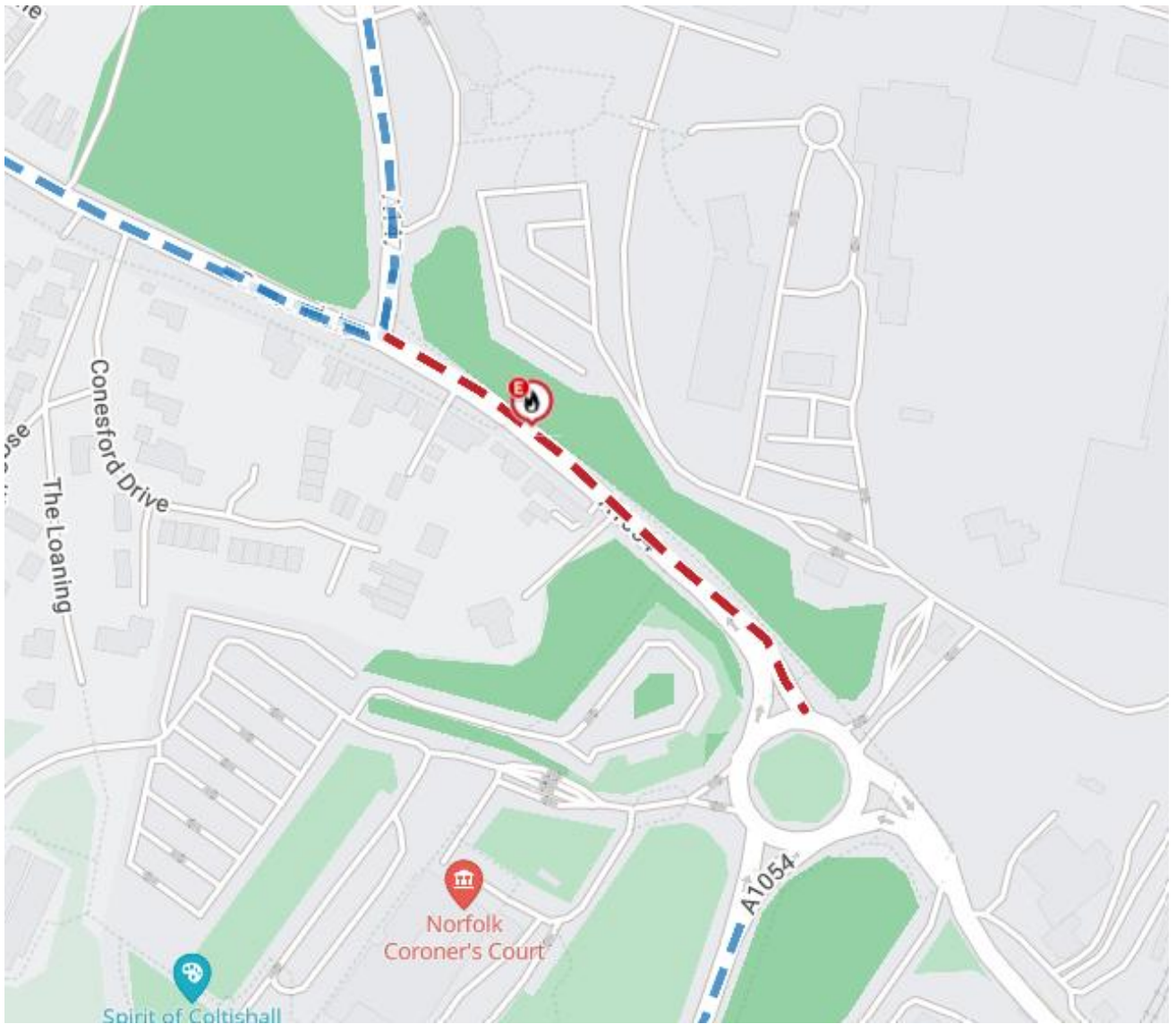
