

**Norfolk County Council (Norwich, Camberley Road, Newmarket Road)**  
**Emergency Notice**  
**Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026**  
**Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

Norwich, Camberley Road and Newmarket Road (CTRO1542) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to emergency tree felling works the use by vehicles (of any class) of the Camberley Road from its junction with Newmarket Road for 40 metres south-eastwards ("Road A") and Newmarket Road from its junction with Upton Road to its junction with Branksome Road ("Road B") in the City of Norwich will be temporarily prohibited/subject to the suspension of existing restrictions as follows:

**Road A** – shall be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access) from 21<sup>st</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2026.

**Road B** - shall be temporarily subject to the suspension of the bus lane to allow all classes of vehicle to travel within the bus lane along the length of Road B only between 09:30 and 15:30 from 21<sup>st</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2026.

Alternative route for Road A is via: Camberley Road, Waverley Road, Branksome Road, Newmarket Road and vice versa.

The works promoter for this closure/suspension is: Highway Safe on behalf of Dr Stump.

The closure/suspension is necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public or serious damage to the Roads A-B or both.

The closure/suspension is anticipated to take place from 21<sup>st</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2026 but the Roads A-B may continue to be closed/subject to a suspension of existing restrictions until the 11<sup>th</sup> May 2026 where the closure/suspension is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works / when the closure/suspension is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 11<sup>th</sup> May 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for an additional 21 days by further Notice and/or for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by further Order.

Any existing restrictions or prohibitions within Orders made under the RTRA 1984 will become suspended where they conflict with the provisions of this Notice during the operation of this Notice.

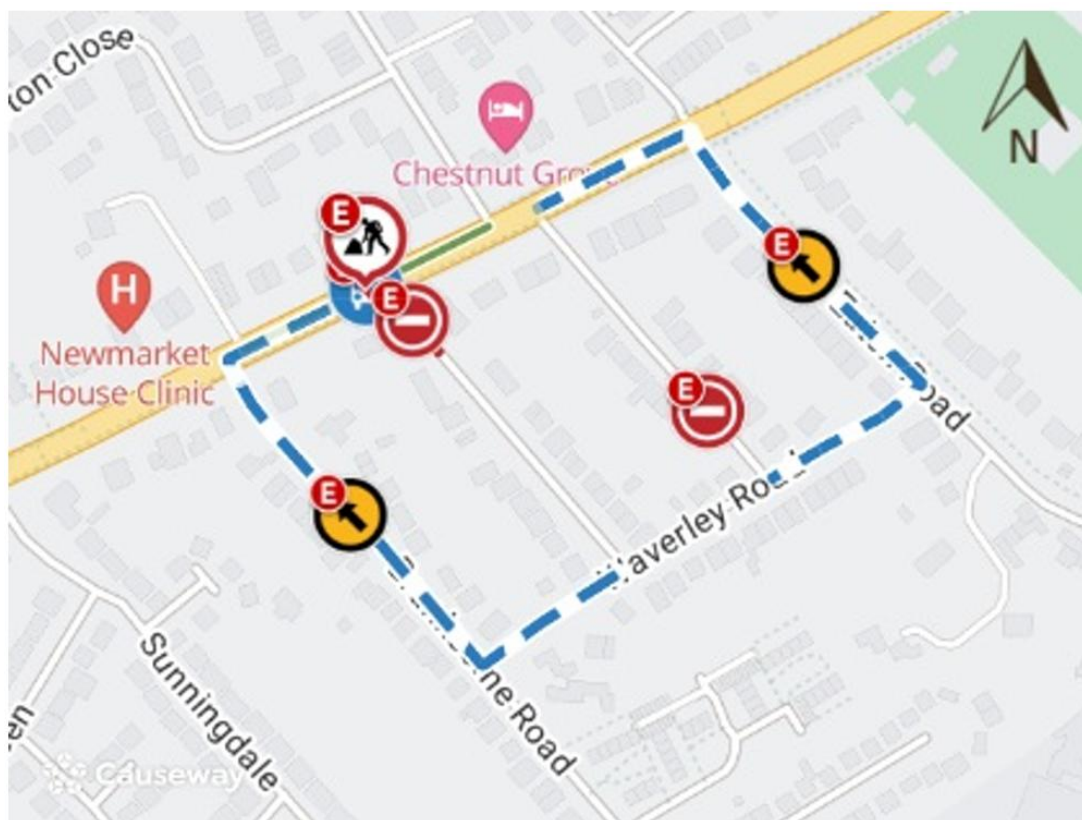
A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

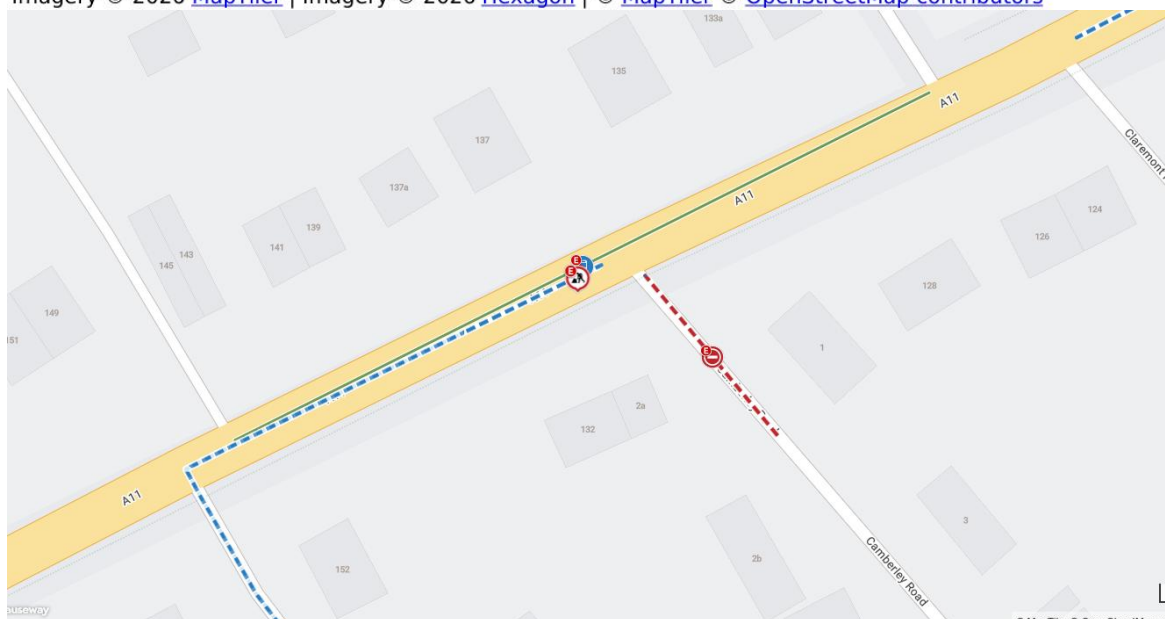
