

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (CTRO1488) affecting the St John Maddermarket from 53 metres north of its junction with Pottergate for 10 metres northwards ("Road A") and Pottergate from its junction with St John Maddermarket to its junction with Wellington Lane ("Road B") and Wellington Lane from its junction with Pottergate to its junction with St Benedicts Street ("Road C") and St Benedicts Street from its junction with Wellington Lane for 56 metres eastwards ("Road D") in the City of Norwich to facilitate telecoms maintenance works, the Road A will be temporarily closed/restricted (except for pedestrian access) and the Roads B–D will be subject to the temporary imposition of a 7.5 tonne weight restriction for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be on 21st April 2026, but may continue to be restricted until the 2nd June 2026 where the restrictions are still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: Road A: Lobster Lane, Exchange Street, St Andrews Street.

The works promoter for these restrictions is: Virgin Media.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Roads A–D where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works/ when the restrictions are no longer necessary or otherwise on the 2nd June 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, the restrictions could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restrictions imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

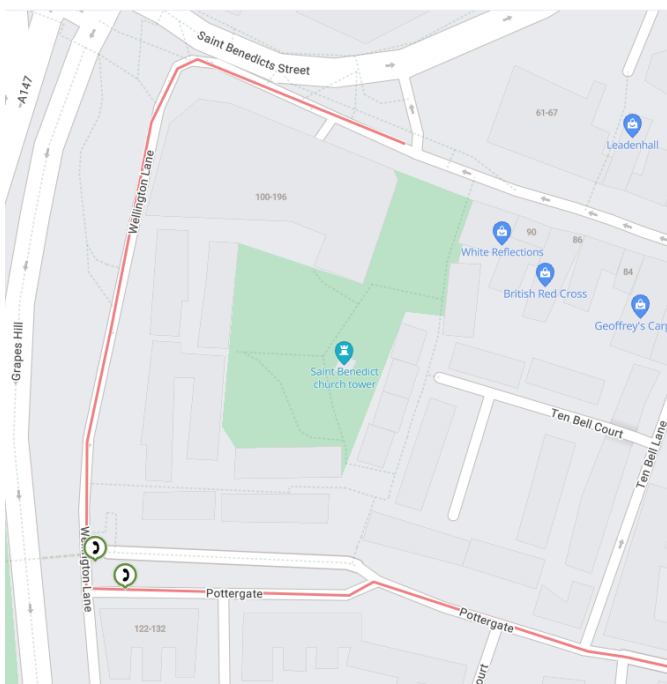
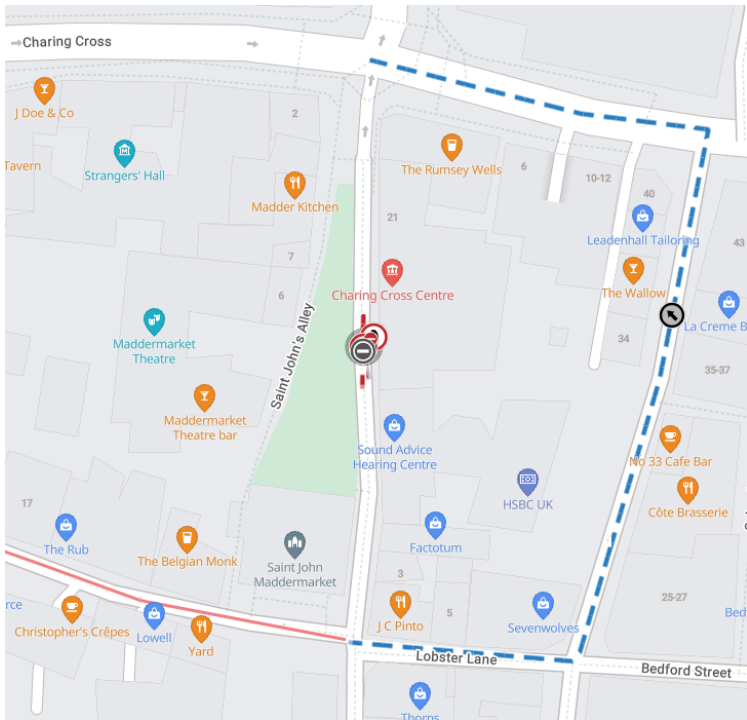
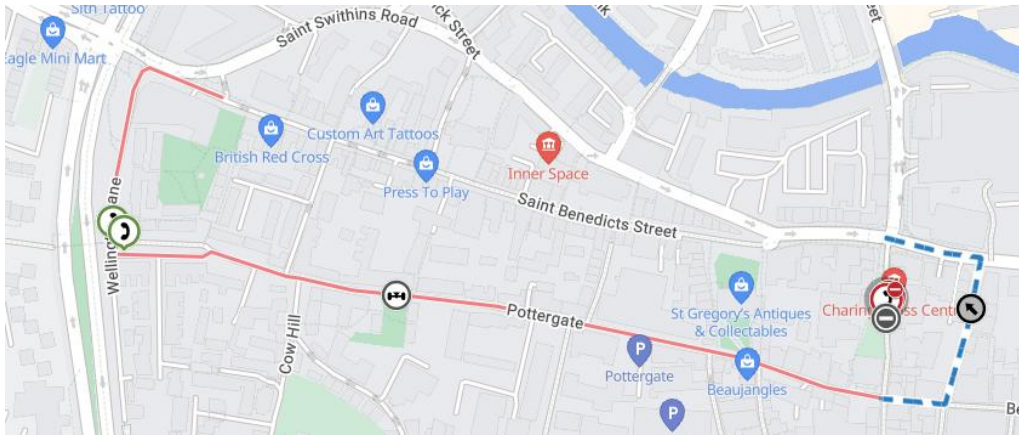
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
