

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (CTRO1497) affecting Theatre Street from its junction with Chapel Field East to its junction with William Booth Street ("Road A") and Theatre Street from 67 metres west of its junction with William Booth Street to its junction with Rampant Horse Street ("Road B") and Rampant Horse Street from its junction with theatre street to its junction with St Stephens Street ("Road C") and St Stephens Street from its junction with Rampant Horse Street to its junction with Chapel Field Road/Queens Road Roundabout ("Road D") in the City of Norwich to facilitate the lifting and installation of a transformer on the roof of the forum, Road A will be temporarily closed/restricted (except for pedestrian access) and Road B, C and D will be temporarily subject to the suspension of the bus lane for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be between 19:00 and 03:00 from 27<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> April 2026, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 9<sup>th</sup> June 2026 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route for Road A is via: Chapel Field East, Chapel Field North, Chapel Field Road, St Stephens Street, Rampant Horse Street and vice versa.

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Norfolk County Council.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Roads where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works/when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 9<sup>th</sup> June 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

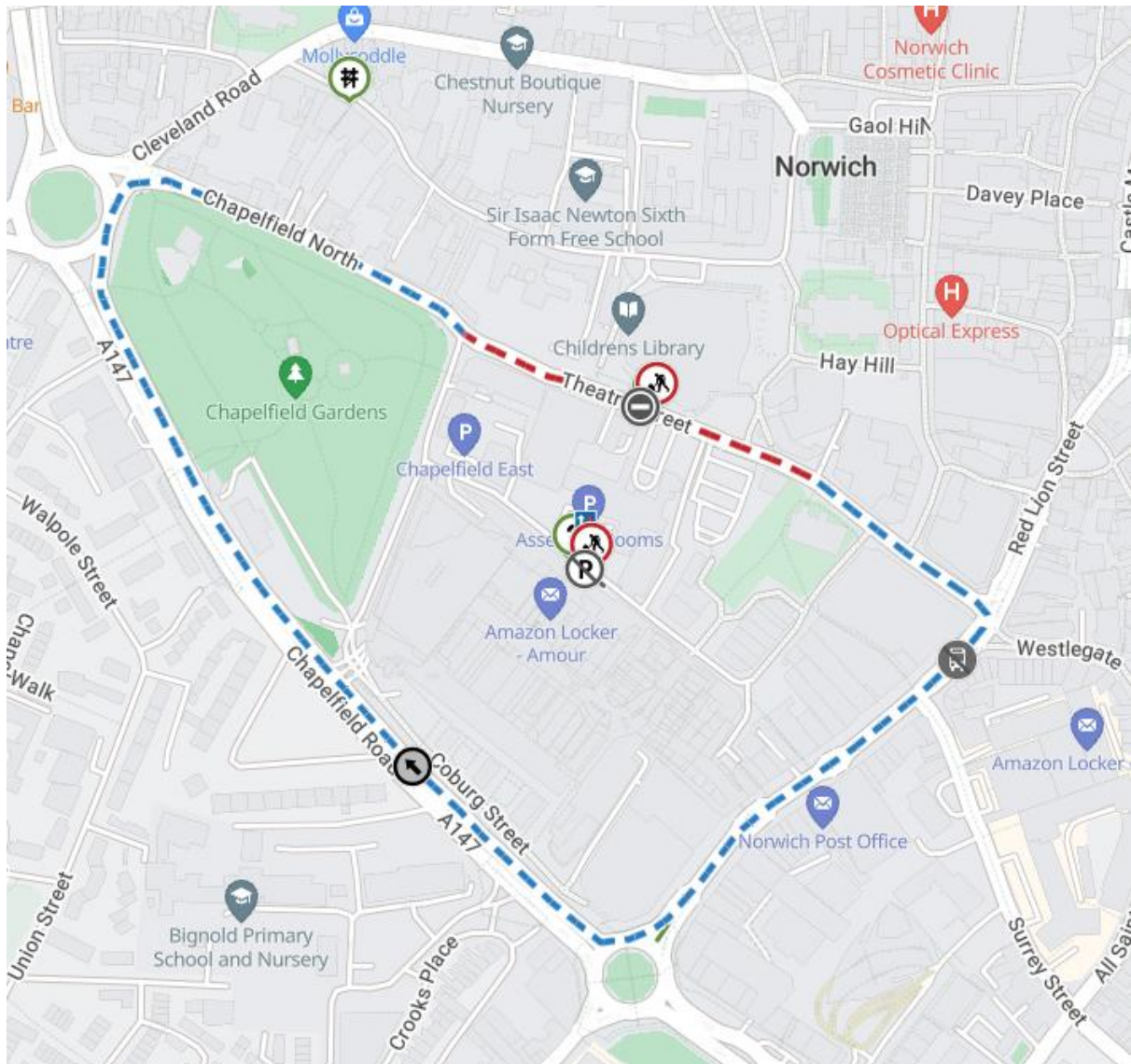
In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
