

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (CTRO1535) affecting Newmarket Road from its junction with Elveden Close to its junction with Brunswick Road (the "Road") in the City of Norwich to facilitate tree works. The Road will be subject to the temporary suspension of the restriction on unpermitted vehicles travelling in the bus lane to allow all classes of vehicles to travel within the bus lane for the duration of the works/period where the suspension is necessary which is anticipated to be between 09:00 and 15:30 from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> June 2026, but may continue to be suspended until the 1<sup>st</sup> August 2026 where the suspension is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

The works promoter for this suspension is: Norfolk County Council.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works/when the suspension is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 1<sup>st</sup> August 2026 without further notice.

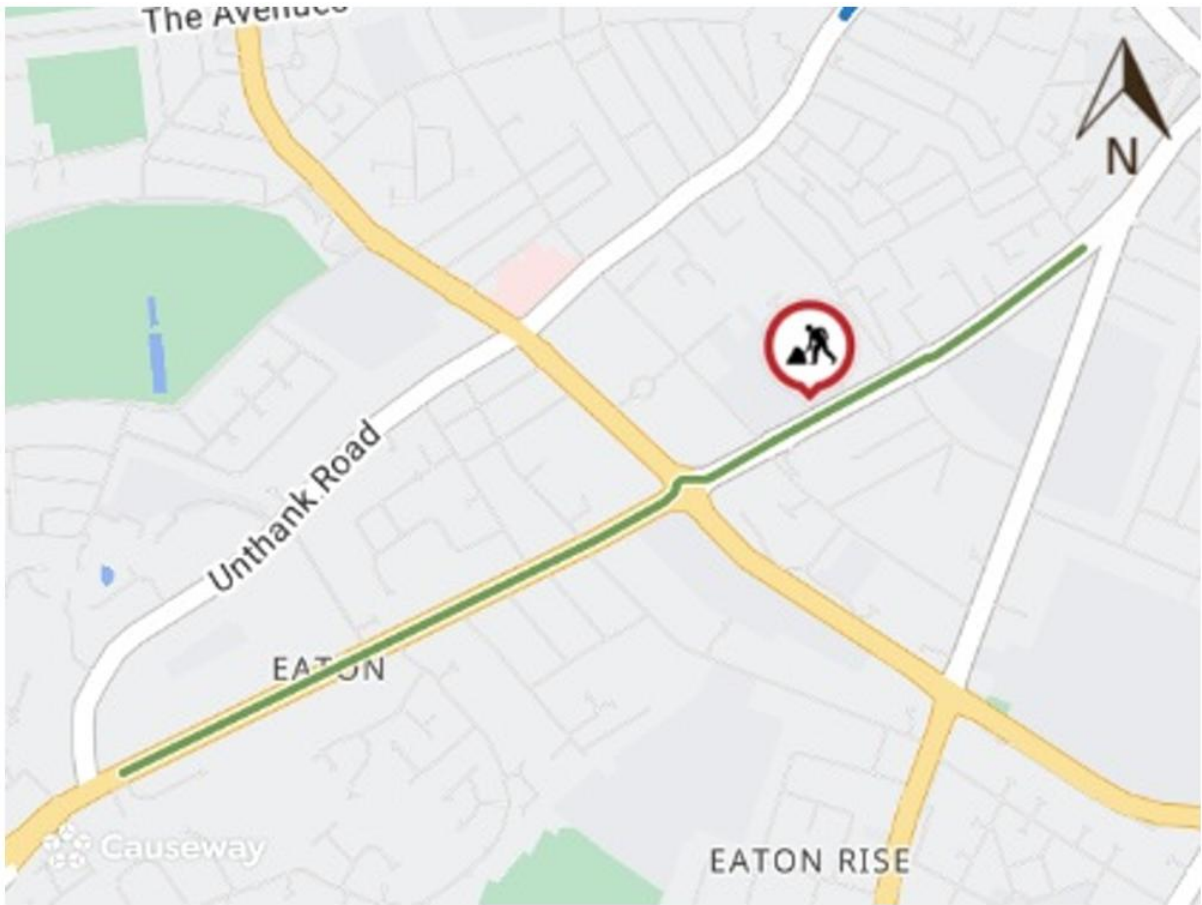
If necessary, the suspension could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
