

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (CTRO1513) affecting Grapes Hill (northbound carriageway only) from its junction with Chapel Field Road Roundabout to its junction with Dereham Road (the "Road") in the City of Norwich to facilitate surface dressing works, the Road will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access) for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be in phases from 25<sup>th</sup> June to 9<sup>th</sup> July 2026, but may continue to be closed until the 19<sup>th</sup> August 2026 where the closure is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

**NB: These works will take place in phases:**

**Phase 1: between 19:00 and 23:00 from 25<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> June 2026 (including two contingency days in case of inclement weather).**

**Phase 2: between 19:00 and 02:00 from 7<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> July 2026 (including two contingency days in case of inclement weather).**

Alternative route is via: Grapes Hill, Chapel Field Road, St Stephens Roundabout, St Stephens Street, Queens Road, Bracondale, King Street, Carrow Road, Koblenz Avenue, Riverside, Riverside Road, Bishop Bridge Road, Ketts Hill, Barrack Street, St Crispins Road, Barn Road and vice versa.

The works promoter for this closure is: Norfolk County Council.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Road where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 19<sup>th</sup> August 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

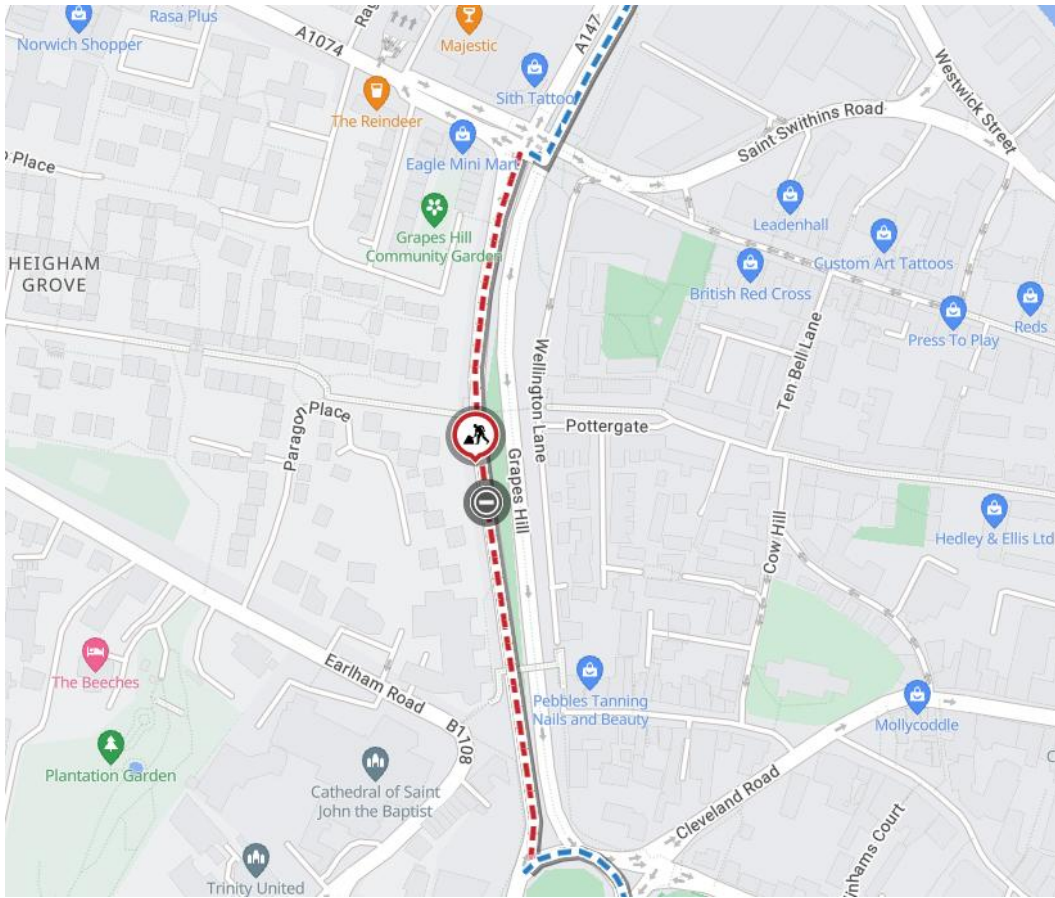
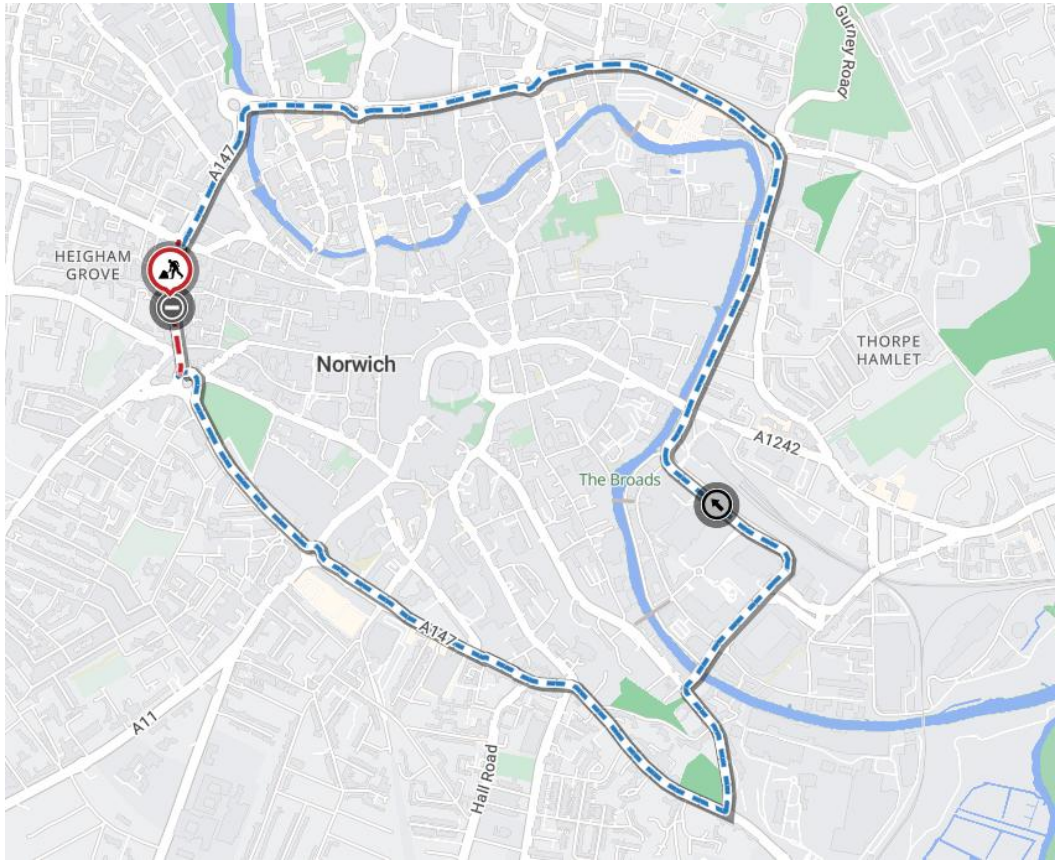
In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
