

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (CTRO1554) affecting the Queens Road loading bays (north side of the carriageway only) from 58 metres southeast of its junction with the St Stephens Street/Queens Road Roundabout for 22.5 metres south-eastwards ("Road A") and St Stephens Street at its junction with Surrey Street ("Road B") in the City of Norwich to facilitate public realm improvement scheme works. Traffic (constituting any class of vehicle) over the Road A shall be temporarily prohibited to park, stop, load, and/or unload and Road B shall be temporarily subject to the suspension of a no right turn restriction allowing traffic (constituting any class of vehicle) to turn right onto Surrey Street for the duration of the works/period the restriction and suspension are necessary which is anticipated to be from 29th June to 10th July 2026, but may continue to be restricted until the 21st August 2026 where the restriction and suspension are still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: N/A.

The works promoter for this restriction is: Norfolk County Council.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Road A and Road B where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the restriction and suspension are no longer necessary or otherwise on the 21st August 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction and suspension could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

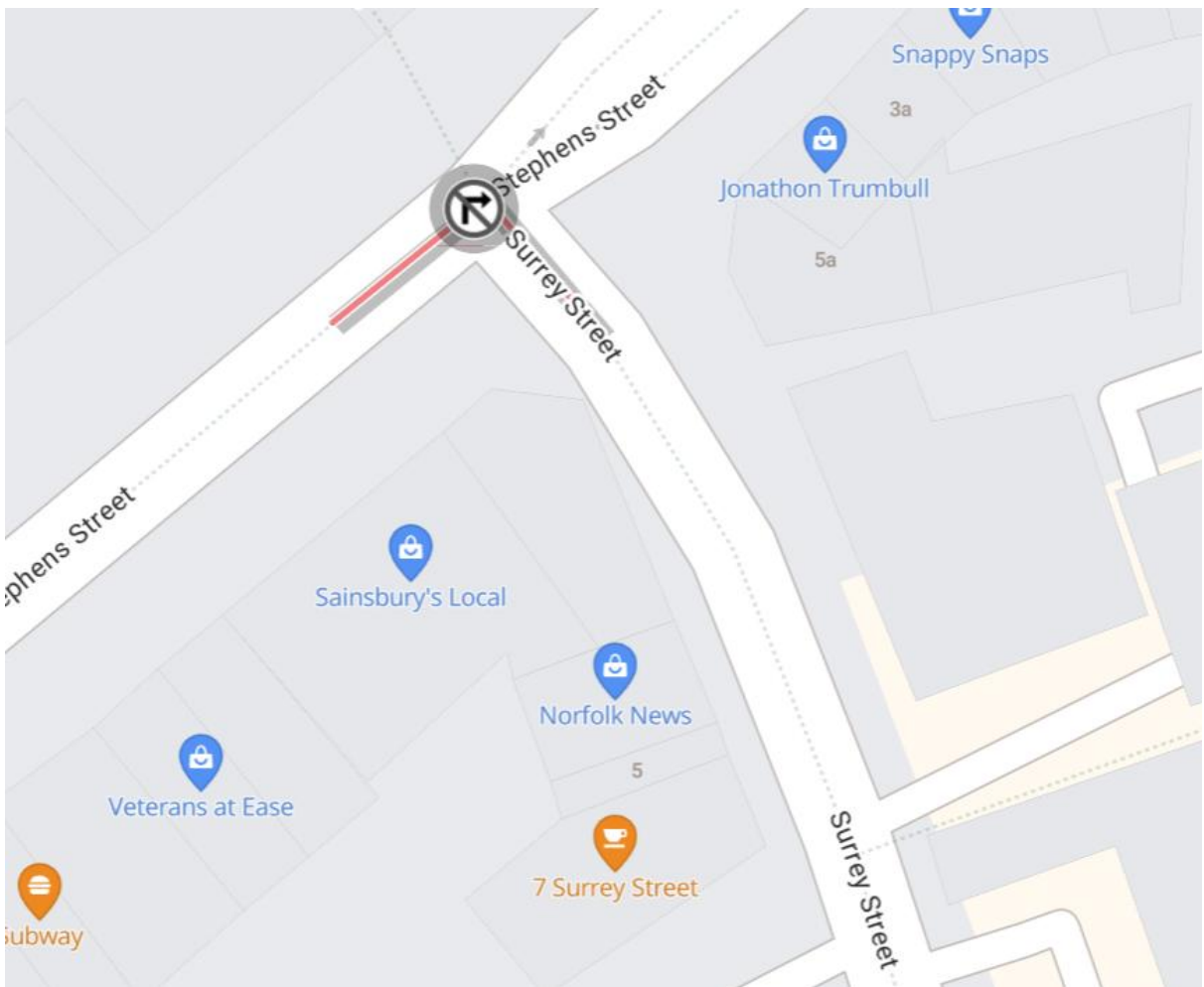
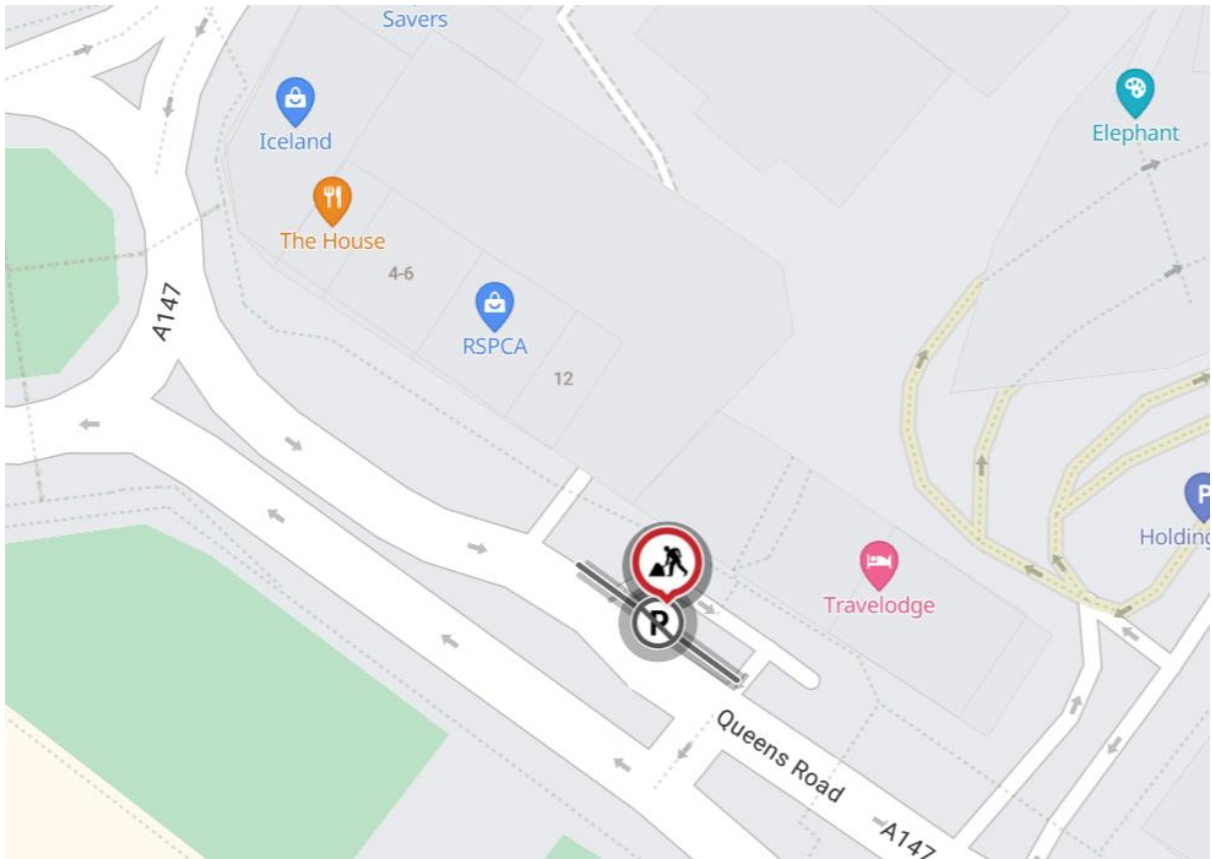
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
