

**Norfolk County Council**  
**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDERS 2026 (NORWICH)**  
**Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984**

Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby give notice that:

(i) **THEY PROPOSE TO MAKE** Temporary Traffic Regulation Orders in respect of the following roads:

**A) QUEENS ROAD LOADING BAYS** (north side of the carriageway only) from 58m southeast of its junction with the St Stephens Street/Queens Road Roundabout for 22.5m south-eastwards and **B) St Stephens Street** at its junction with Surrey Street to facilitate public realm improvement scheme works. Traffic (constituting any class of vehicle) over Road A shall be temporarily prohibited to park, stop, load, and/or unload and Road B shall be temporarily subject to the suspension of a no right turn restriction allowing traffic (constituting any class of vehicle) to turn right onto Surrey Street from St Stephens Street from 29th June to 10th July 2026 (may continue until 21st August 2026). Alternative route is via: N/A. The works promoter is Norfolk County Council.

**SOTHERTON ROAD** - from its junction with Parmentor Road to its junction with Buckingham Road to facilitate footway patching works from 30<sup>th</sup> June to 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2026 (may continue until 14<sup>th</sup> August 2026). Alternative route is via: Buckingham Road, Sotherton Road and vice versa. The works promoter is Norfolk County Council.

(ii) **THEY HAVE MADE** Temporary Traffic Regulation Orders in respect of the following roads:

**GRAPES HILL (NORTHBOUND CARRIAGEWAY ONLY)** - from its junction with Chapel Field Road Roundabout to its junction with Dereham Road to facilitate surface dressing works from 25<sup>th</sup> June to 9<sup>th</sup> July 2026 (may continue until 19<sup>th</sup> August 2026). Alternative route is via: Grapes Hill, Chapel Field Road, St Stephens Roundabout, St Stephens Street, Queens Road, Bracondale, King Street, Carrow Road, Koblenz Avenue, Riverside, Riverside Road, Bishop Bridge Road, Ketts Hill, Barrack Street, St Crispins Road, Barn Road and vice versa. The works promoter is Norfolk County Council. **NB: These works will take place in phases: Phase 1) between 19:00 and 23:00 from 25<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> June 2026. Phase 2) between 19:00 and 02:00 from 7<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> July 2026. Each phase includes two contingency days in case of inclement weather.**

**IPSWICH ROAD** - from its junction with Tuckswood Lane to its junction with Hall Road to facilitate surface dressing and lining works from 22<sup>nd</sup> June to 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2026 (may continue until 13<sup>th</sup> August 2026). Alternative route is via: Hall Road, Lakenham Road and vice versa. The works promoter is Norfolk County Council. **NB: These works will take place in phases: Phase 1) between 19:00 and 23:59 from 22<sup>nd</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2026. Phase 2) between 19:00 and 23:59 from 30<sup>th</sup> June to 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2026. The 23<sup>rd</sup> June and 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2026 are contingency dates in case of inclement weather.**

**NEWMARKET ROAD** - from its junction with Daniels Road to its junction with Camberley Road to facilitate surface dressing works from 24<sup>th</sup> June to 7<sup>th</sup> July 2026 (may continue until 18<sup>th</sup> August 2026). Alternative route is via: Daniels Road, Ipswich Road, Norwich Southern Bypass, A47 Through J A140 E, A47 Through J A140 W, Southern Bypass Keswick To Colney, A47 J A140 Join W, A47 From J A11/B1172 To J A140 E, A47 From J A140 To J A11/B1172 W, A47 Through J A11/B1172 W, A47 Through J A11/B1172 E, Newmarket Road (Norwich, Cringleford, Hethersett, Keswick and Intwood, Caistor St. Edmund and Bixley, Ketteringham). The works promoter is Norfolk County Council. **NB: These works will take place in phases: Phase 1) between 19:00 and 23:00 from 24<sup>th</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> June 2026. Phase 2) between 19:00 and 23:59 from 5<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> July 2026.**

Unless otherwise stated, the effect of these Orders will be to prohibit the use by traffic of the named road(s)/ footpath(s). In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance. Where an Order is for a reason other than works it is because of the likelihood of danger to the public or of serious damage to the road/footpath. **Anticipated dates are stated but the Orders may continue until the end date where necessary or required.** The Orders are revoked on the end date or on the actual date of removal of the prohibition/restriction where earlier without further notice. If necessary, the restrictions can have a maximum duration of 18 months or 6 months in respect of footpaths, cycle tracks, bridleways, restricted byways, and byways open to all traffic (BOAT).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
