

**Norfolk County Council (Norwich, Waldeck Road)
Emergency Notice
Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026
Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

Norwich, Waldeck Road (8203-9198-2202-7601) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE of the following emergency temporary traffic restrictions affecting Waldeck Road from its junction with Leopold Road for 56 metres north-eastwards ("Road A") and Waldeck Road from its junction with Mile End Road to its junction with Leopold Road ("Road B") in the City of Norwich. Owing to pipe repair works, the use by vehicles (of any class) of the Road A will be temporarily prohibited and the Road B shall be temporarily subject to the suspension of the one-way system (west bound) to allow vehicles to travel in both an easterly and westerly direction.

In respect of Road A, the alternative route is via: Leopold Road, Unthank Road, Mile End Road and vice versa.

The works promoter for the closure and suspension is: Anglian Water.

The suspension and closure are necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public or serious damage to the Roads A and B or both.

The closure and suspension are anticipated to take place from 24th to 30th June 2026 but the Roads A and B may continue to be closed/suspended until the 14th July 2026 where the closure and/or suspension are still required beyond the anticipated dates.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works / when the closure and suspension are no longer necessary or otherwise on the 14th July 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for an additional 21 days by further Notice and/or for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by further Order.

Any existing restrictions or prohibitions within Orders made under the RTRA 1984 will become suspended where they conflict with the provisions of this Notice during the operation of this Notice.

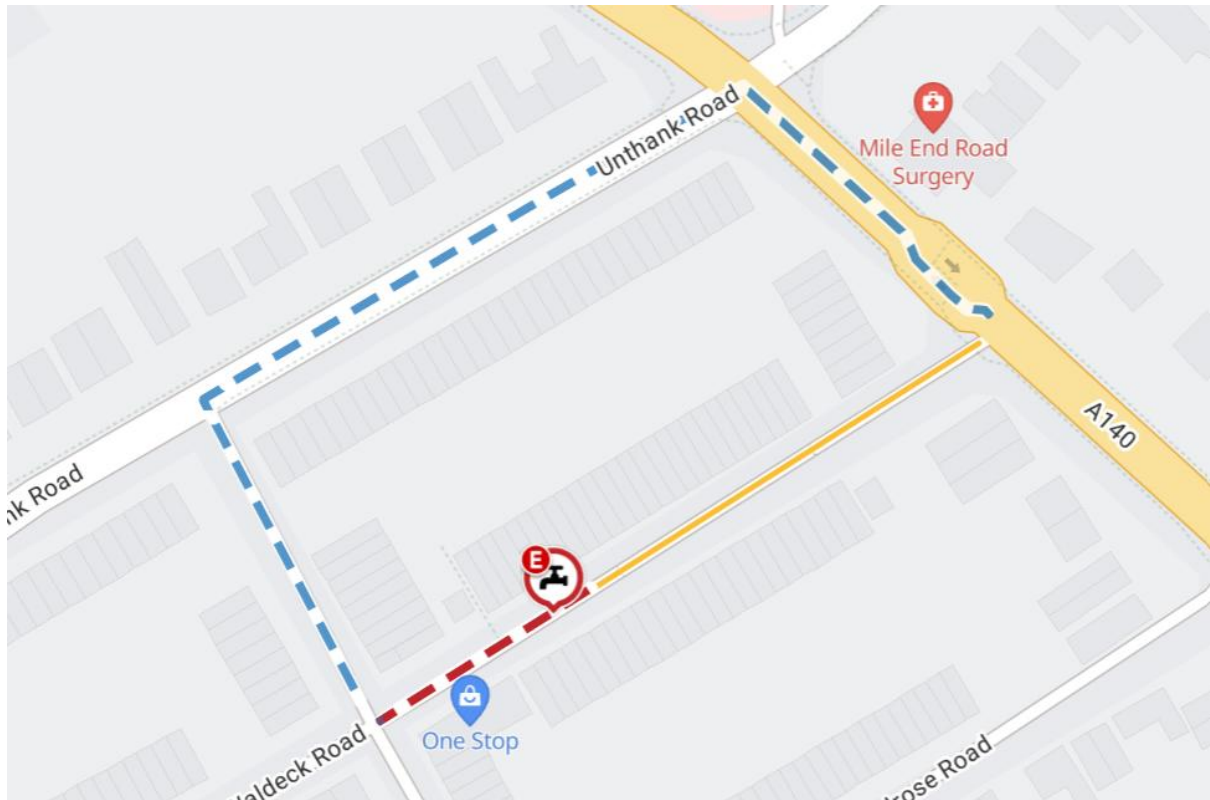
A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the closure and/or suspension imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
