

Norfolk County Council (Norwich, Bracondale)
Emergency Continuation Notice
Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026
Section 14(2) and 15(8)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Norwich, Bracondale (4285-1950-7528-0389) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) and 15(8)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to gas leak repair works the use by vehicles (of any class) Bracondale from its junction with Martineau Lane Roundabout to its junction with King Street (the "Road") in the City of Norwich will continue to be temporarily subject to the imposition of a 20 miles per hour speed restriction.

Alternative route is via: N/A.

The works promoter for this restriction is: Cadent.

The restriction is necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public or serious damage to the Road or both.

The restriction is anticipated to take place from 5th to 8th July 2026 (previously 15th June to 5th July 2026) but the Road may continue to be restricted until the 25th July 2026 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works / when the restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 8th July 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum of 18 months from the date the first Notice was effective by further Order.

Any existing restrictions or prohibitions within Orders made under the RTRA 1984 will become suspended where they conflict with the provisions of this Notice during the operation of this Notice.

This Notice shall not apply to any member of the Police Force, Fire and Rescue Service, Ambulance Service, a vehicle being used by Special Forces during the execution of their duties or to any person acting with the permission or upon the direction of a Police Officer in uniform.

No speed limit imposed by this Notice applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

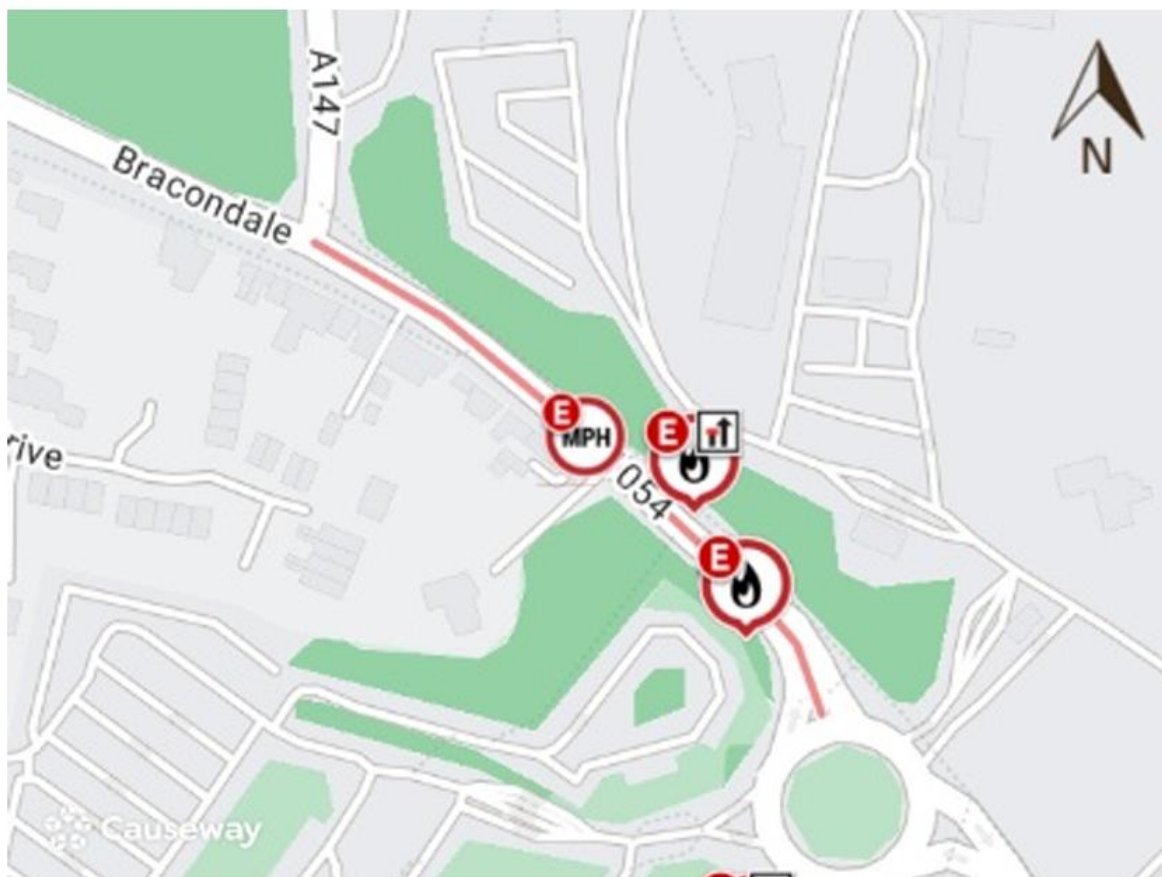
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
