

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (CTRO1580) affecting **A) Carrow Road** from its junction with Thorpe Road to its junction with Barton Road ("Road A"); **B) Carrow Road** from its junction with Thorpe Road to its junction with Clarence Road ("Road B"); **C) Thorpe Road** from its junction with Carrow Road to its junction with Clarence Road ("Road C") and **D) Thorpe Road** from its junction with Lower Clarence Road to its junction with Riverside ("Road D") in the City of Norwich to facilitate subsidence investigation and repair works. Road A will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access), Road B shall be temporarily subject to the suspension of the one-way system (southwest bound) to allow vehicles to travel in both a northeast and southwest direction, Road C shall be temporarily subject to the suspension of the bus lane to allow vehicles to travel eastwards along Road C and Road D shall be temporarily subject to the suspension of the bus lane and bus gate to allow vehicles to travel eastwards along Road D for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be from 27th to 31st July 2026, but may continue to be closed/suspended until the 11th September 2026 where the closure/suspension is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route for Road A is via: Westbound on Thorpe Road - Thorpe Road, Riverside, Koblenz Avenue and Canary Way. Eastbound on Thorpe Road to Carrow Road - Thorpe Road, Yarmouth Road, Yarmouth Road Roundabout with Northside, Yarmouth Road, Thorpe Road, Riverside, Koblenz Avenue and Canary Way.

The works promoter for this closure/suspension is: Norfolk County Council.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in Road A where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works/when the closure/restriction/suspension is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 11th September 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, the closure/suspension could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.

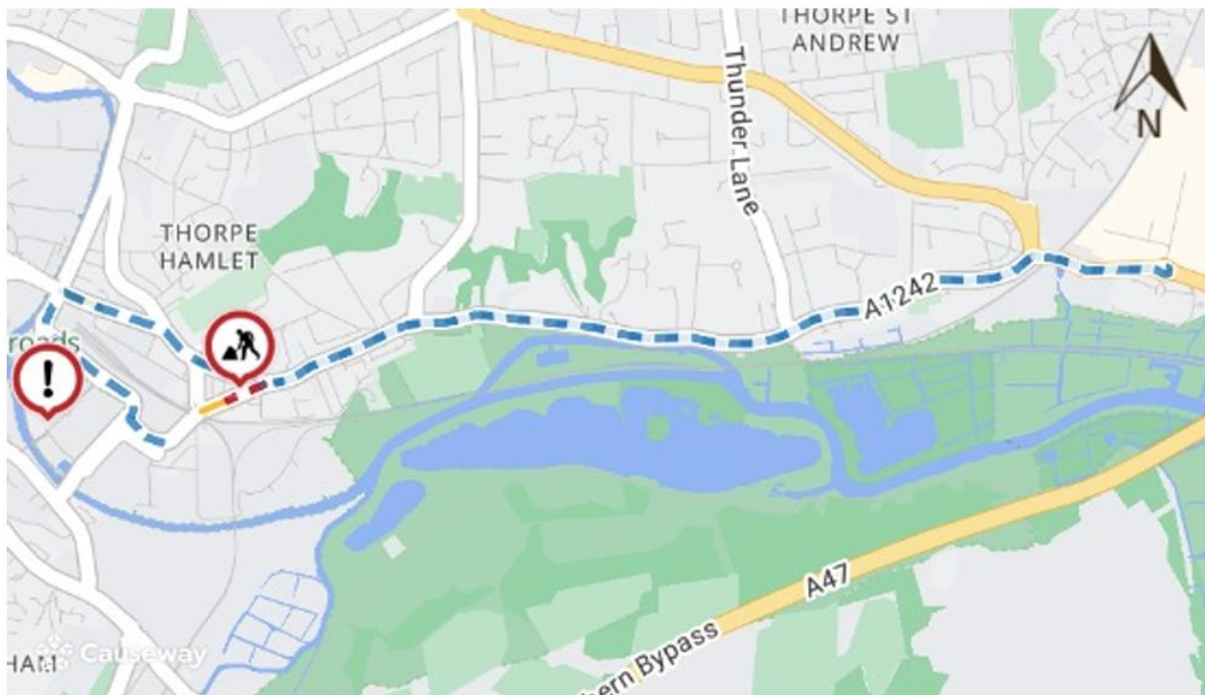
