

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (CTRO1573) affecting **A) Carrow Hill** from its junction with Bracondale for 30 metres eastwards ("Road A") and **B) Carrow Hill** from its junction with King Street to its junction with Bracondale ("Road B") in the City of Norwich to facilitate water connection works. The Road A will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access) and Road B shall be temporarily subject to the suspension of the one-way system (west bound) to allow vehicles to travel in both an easterly and westerly direction for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be from 22<sup>nd</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> July 2026, but may continue to be closed/suspended until the 4<sup>th</sup> September 2026 where the closure/suspension is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: Carrow Hill, King Street and Bracondale.

The works promoter for this closure/suspension is: Anglian Water.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Road A where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works/when the closure and suspension is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 4<sup>th</sup> September 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, the closure/suspension could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

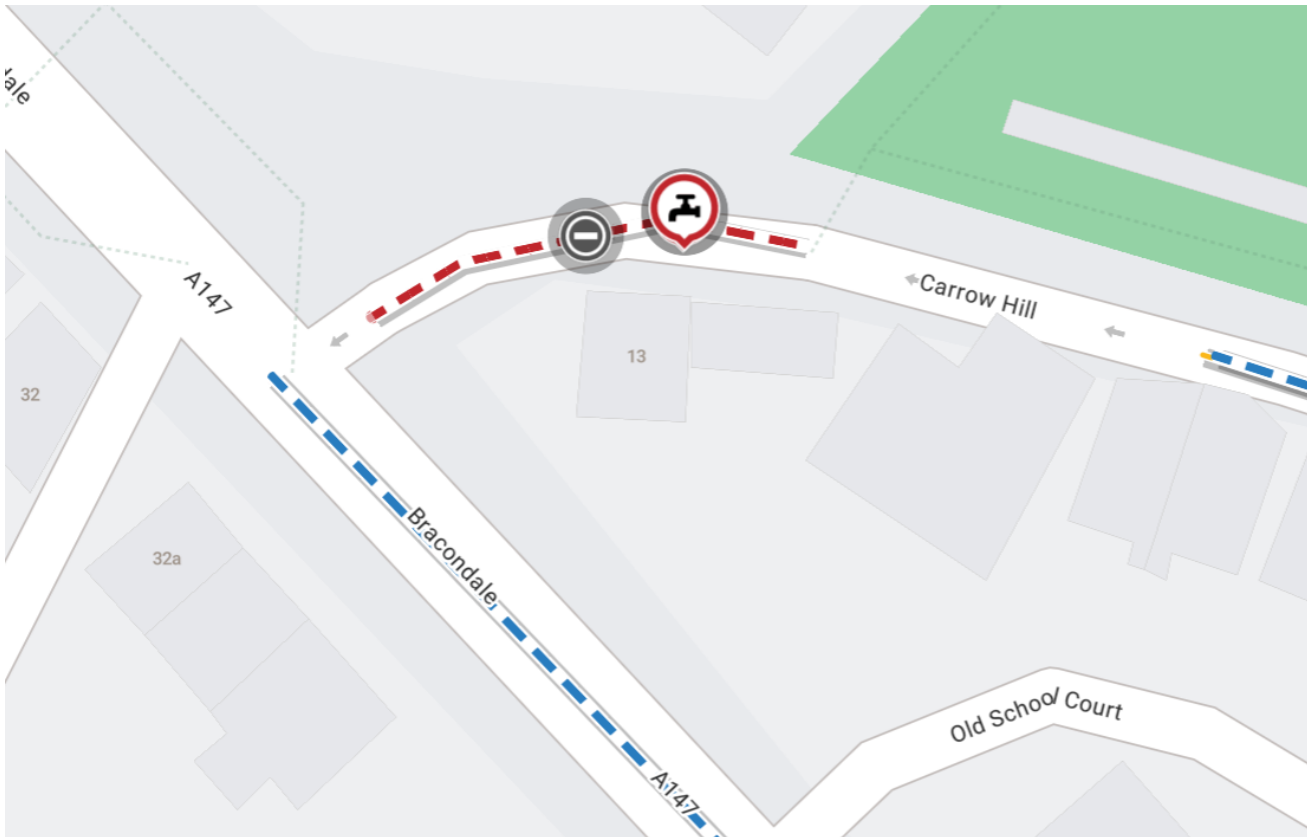
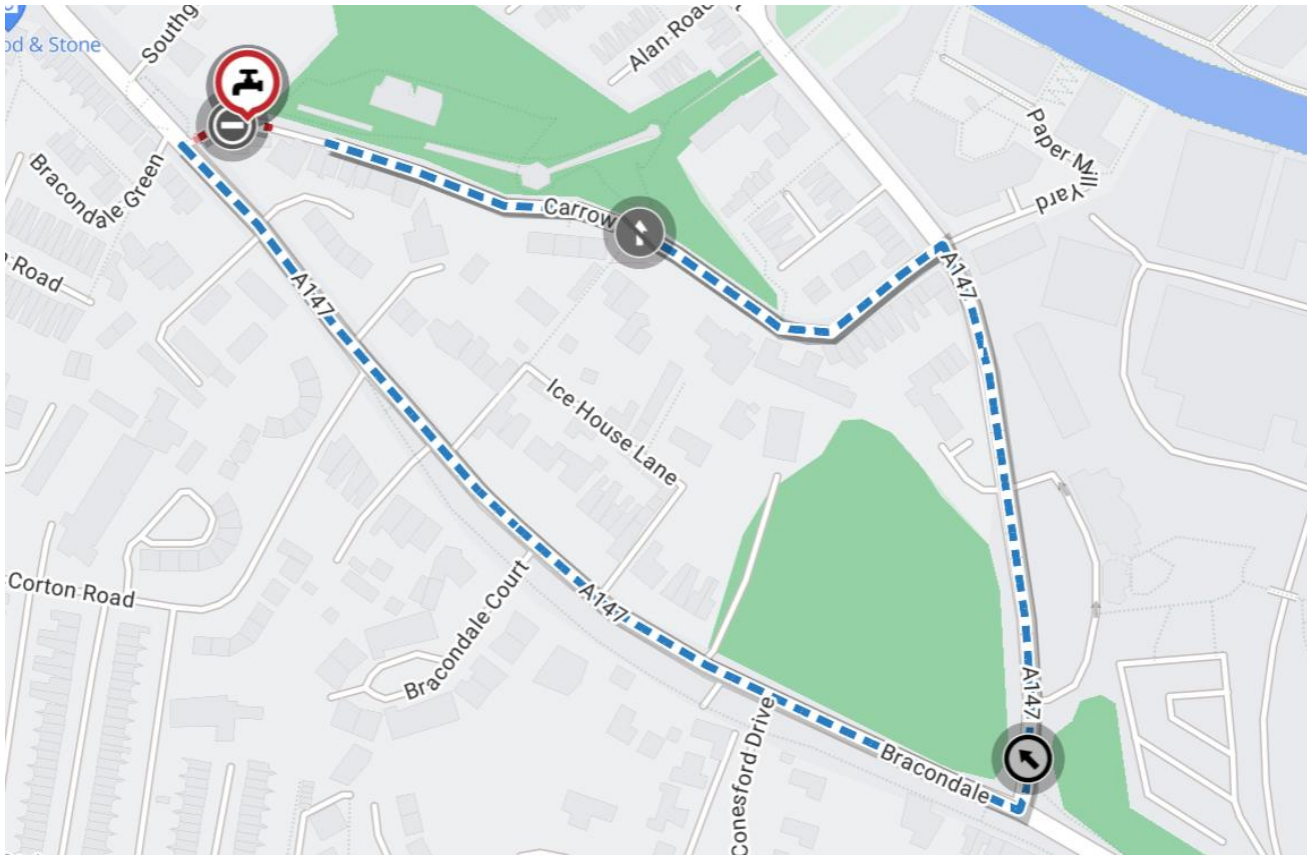
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
