M – Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives:

a) General – all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e) [\(please read guidance note 9 \(opens in a new tab\)\)](#)

KD Fast Food is committed to promoting the four licensing objectives. All staff will receive training in responsible alcohol sales, Challenge 25, customer service and licensing requirements. A refusals register and incident log will be maintained. CCTV will be installed before licensable activities commence and will be maintained in good working order. The premises will be well managed, kept clean and safe, and we will cooperate fully with the Police, Norwich City Council and other responsible authorities.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

CCTV will be installed before licensable activities commence. Staff will operate a Challenge 25 policy, maintain a refusals register and incident log, and refuse service to anyone who is intoxicated or underage. Any incidents of crime or disorder will be reported to the Police where appropriate.

c) Public safety

The premises will be maintained in a safe and hygienic condition at all times. Fire safety equipment and emergency exits will be kept clear and regularly checked. Staff will be trained in emergency procedures, food hygiene and customer safety. Adequate lighting will be provided throughout the premises. Any spillages or hazards will be dealt with promptly to reduce the risk of accidents. The premises will comply with all relevant fire, health and safety, and food safety legislation.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

The premises will be operated in a manner that minimises disturbance to local residents and neighbouring businesses. Staff will monitor customers leaving the premises and display notices requesting customers to leave quietly and respect nearby residents. Litter will be regularly cleared from outside the premises. Waste collections and deliveries will be managed to minimise noise where reasonably practicable. Background music will be kept at an appropriate level so as not to cause a nuisance to neighbours.

e) The protection of children from harm

KD Fast Food is committed to protecting children from harm. A Challenge 25 policy will be operated, and anyone who appears to be under the age of 25 will be required to produce valid photographic identification before being served alcohol. Acceptable identification will include a passport, UK photocard driving licence or PASS-approved proof of age card. Staff will receive training on age verification procedures and the responsible sale of alcohol. A refusals register will be maintained, and alcohol will not be sold to anyone under the age of 18 or to adults attempting to purchase alcohol on behalf of children. Children under the age of 16 should be accompanied by a responsible adult while on the premises.

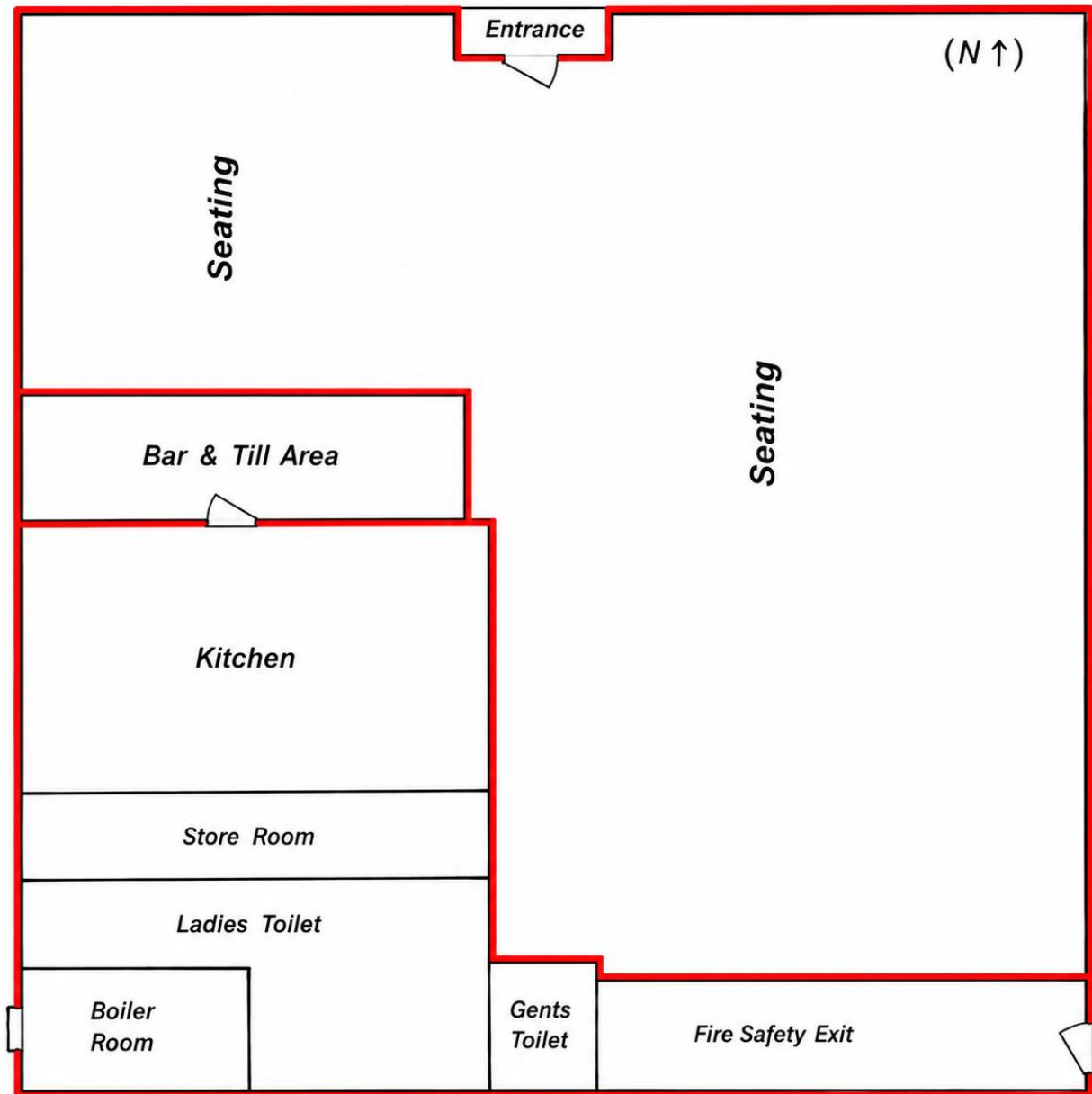
