

**Norfolk County Council (Norwich, Norwich Theatre Royal Family
Festival, 151132328)**

Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026 – Notice

**Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“RTRA 1984”)
as amended by the Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1994**

Norfolk County Council, hereby gives notice that to facilitate the Norwich Theatre Royal Family Festival event, it intends to make an Order under Section 16A of the RTRA 1984 and all other enabling powers with the consent of the Secretary of State, the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict/prohibit vehicular traffic on the **A) Theatre Street** from 57 metres east of its junction with Chapelfield East for 100 metres eastwards (“Road A”), and suspending the existing restriction on **B) St Stephens Street** from its junction with St Stephens Roundabout to its junction with Red Lion Street (“Road B”), and **C) Rampant Horse Street** from its junction with Brigg Street to its Junction with Red Lion Street (“Road C”) in the City of Norwich.

The Order shall be in effect (in force) on the 4th August 2026 until the restrictions are no longer necessary on that date. The Road A will be temporarily restricted (except for emergency and pedestrian access), and the Roads B and C shall be temporarily subject to the suspension of the bus lane for the duration of the Norwich Theatre Royal Family Festival event which is anticipated to be between 12:30 and 14:15. The restrictions specified will only have effect at such times and to such extent as indicated by the display of on-site signs.

Alternative route will be via: Theatre Street, Rampant Horse Street, St Stephens Street, Chapel Field Road, Chapel Field North.

The promoter of the event is Norwich Theatre Royal.

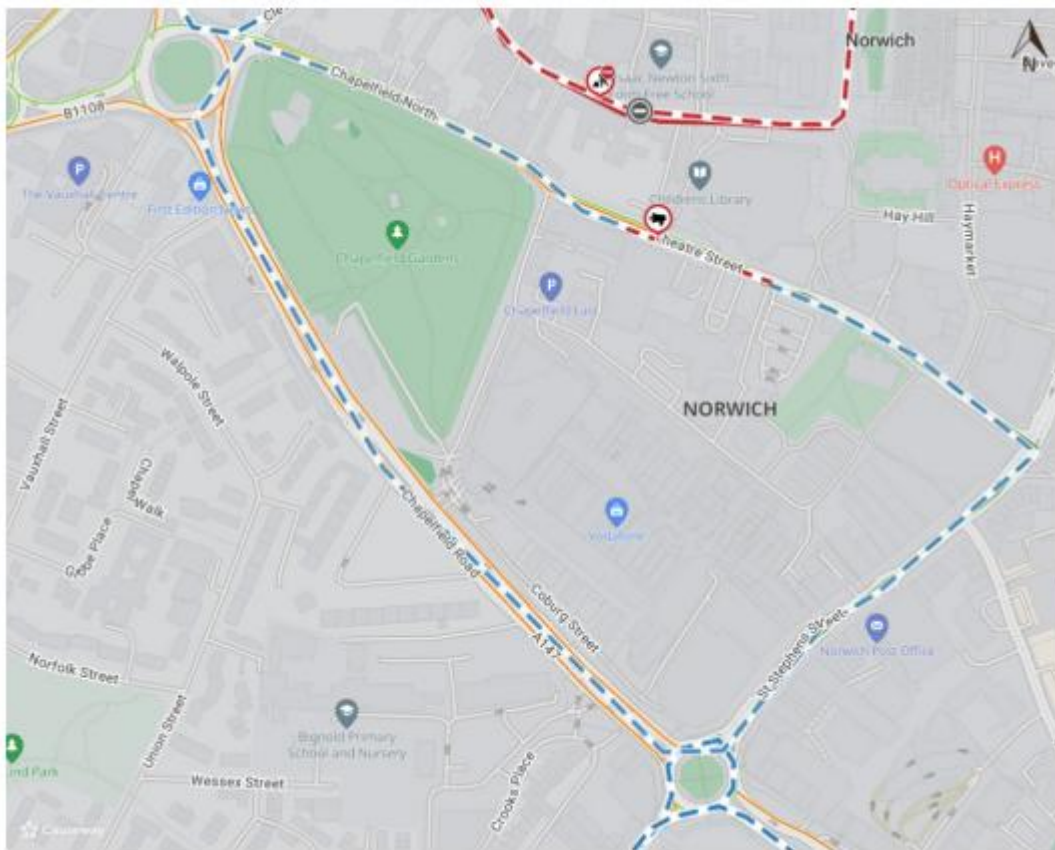
A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of, a restriction or prohibition imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.
