(Norwich, Corton House & Brewster Court Summer Fete)
Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2025 – Notice
Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“RTRA 1984”)
as amended by the Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1994

Norfolk County Council, hereby give notice that to facilitate the Corton House & Brewster Court Summer Fete, they intend to make an Order under Section 16A of the RTRA 1984 and all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to temporarily remove parking restrictions for Zone Y.

Roads where permit parking restrictions will be removed:

- a. C818 City Road (from the junction with A147 Bracondale south to the junction with U41621 Cricket Ground Road); U41621 Cricket Ground Road (entire length); U41610 Carlyle Road (entire length); U41612 Carshalton Road (entire length); U41619 Corton Road (entire length); U41619 Clyffe Cottages (entire length); U41623 Doman Road (entire length); Bracondale Green (entire length); U41611 Carrow Hill (entire length); U45545 Ice House Lane (entire length); A147 Bracondale (from its junction with C818 City Road south to the junction of U41617 Conesford Drive). All other parking restrictions will still apply.

In the Parish of Norwich.

The Order shall be in effect (in force) on Saturday 29 August 2026 and or until the restrictions are no longer necessary, whichever is the earliest. The roads will be temporarily restricted (except for emergency and pedestrian access) for the duration of the Corton House & Brewster Court Summer Fete, which is anticipated to be between 9am to 5pm. The restrictions specified will only have effect at such times and to such extent as indicated by the display of on-site signs.

The promoter of the event is Corton House & Brewster Court.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of, a restriction or prohibition imposed by this Order shall be guilty of an offence.
