

Notice of 4788-6309-3182-6426, Norwich, Dibden Road

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (4788-6309-3182-6426) affecting Dibden Road from 50 metres east of its junction with Crome Road for 40 metres eastwards (the "Road") in the City of Norwich to facilitate building development works, the Road will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access) for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be from 21st September 2026 to 17th October 2028.

Alternative route is via: N/A.

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Norfolk County Council.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Road where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 17th October 2028 without further notice.

Norfolk County Council as Traffic Authority for the Administrative County of Norfolk is satisfied that the execution of the works in question will take longer than 18 months.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

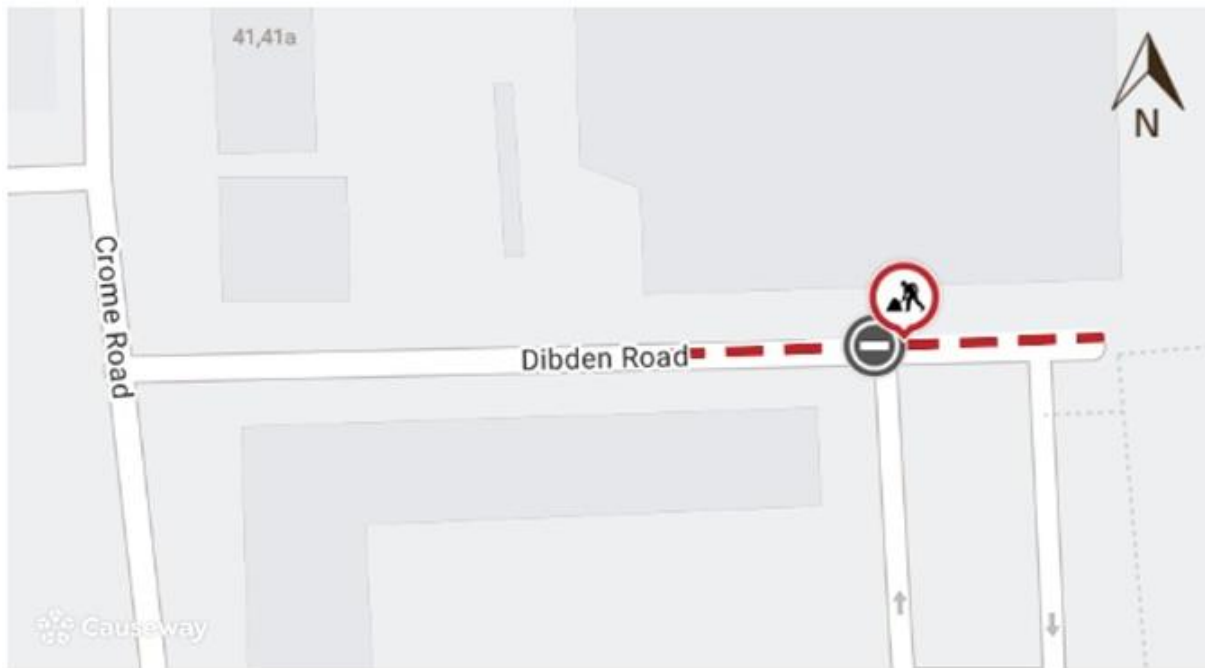
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
