

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (CTRO1553) affecting:

- A) St Leonards Road** from its junction with Guelph Road for 140 metres south-westwards ("Road A");
- B) St Leonards Road** from its junction with Quebec Road to its junction with Ella Road (both sides of the carriageway) ("Road B");
- C) Marion Road** from its junction with St Leonards Road for 22 metres south-eastwards ("Road C");
- D) Marion Road** from its junction with St Leonards Road to its junction with Hill House Road (both sides of the carriageway) ("Road D");
- E) Florence Road** from its junction with St Leonards Road for 20 metres south-eastwards ("Road E");
- F) Florence Road** from its junction with St Leonards Road to its junction with Hill House Road (both sides of the carriageway) ("Road F");
- G) Beatrice Road** from its junction with St Leonards Road for 24 metres south-eastwards ("Road G");
- H) Beatrice Road** from its junction with St Leonards Road to its junction with Hill House Road (both sides of the carriageway) ("Road H");
- I) Quebec Road** from its junction with St Leonards Road for 34 metres north-eastwards (both sides of the carriageway) ("Road I"); and
- J) Hill House Road** from its junction with Beatrice Road to its junction with Rosary Road (both sides of the carriageway) ("Road J")

in the City of Norwich to facilitate drainage works. Road A, Road C, Road E and Road G will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access) and traffic (constituting any class of vehicle) over Road B, Road D, Road F, Road H, Road I and Road J shall be temporarily prohibited to park, stop, load, and/or unload on either side of the carriageway for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be from 31st August to 30th October 2026, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 30th April 2027 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: **Eastbound** - Rosary Road, Thorpe Road, Telegraph Lane East, Telegraph Lane West and Quebec Road. **Westbound** - Quebec Road, Telegraph Lane West, Telegraph Lane East, Thorpe Road, Carrow Road, Clarence Road, Thorpe Road and Rosary Road.

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Norfolk County Council.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Roads A-J where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works/when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 30th April 2027 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

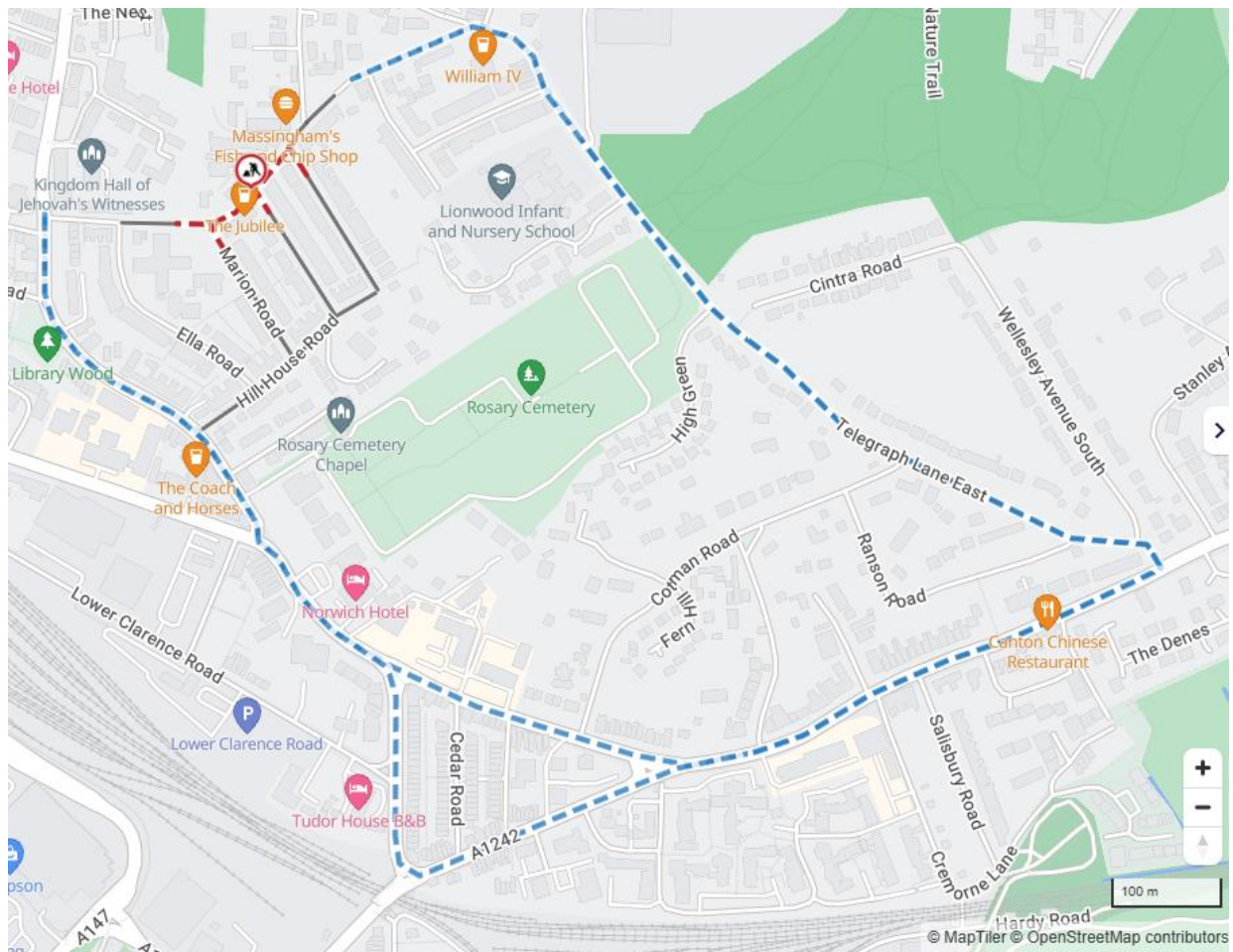
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
