

Norfolk County Council (Norwich, Galley Hill Dash)
Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026 – Notice
Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“RTRA 1984”)
as amended by the Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1994

Norfolk County Council, hereby give notice that to facilitate the Galley Hill Dash, they intend to make an Order under Section 16A of the RTRA 1984 and all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict/prohibit vehicular traffic on the:

- a. **U41419 Galley Hill**, from its junction with A1067 Drayton Road to its junction with U41408 Bowers Avenue

in the City of Norwich.

The Order shall be in effect (in force) on 19 September 2026 and or until the restrictions are no longer necessary, whichever is the earliest. The roads will be temporarily restricted (except for emergency and pedestrian access) for the duration of the Galley Hill Dash which is anticipated to be between 9am and 1pm. The restrictions specified will only have effect at such times and to such extent as indicated by the display of on-site signs.

Alternative route will be via: U41408 Bowers Avenue, U41405 Bignold Road, A1067 Drayton Road.

The promoter of the event is Norwich City Council.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of, a restriction or prohibition imposed by this Order shall be guilty of an offence.
