Urgent Notice
Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026
Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Norwich, St Cripsins Road (4818-6417-1478-2748) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to bridge joint repair works the use by vehicles (of any class) of the A147/120 St Cripsins Road from 5 metres east of its junction with Pitt Street for 435 metres eastwards (the "Road A") and the A147/121 from 5 metres west of its junction with Whitefriars for 435 metres westwards (the "Road B") in the City of Norwich will be temporarily prohibited/restricted.

Alternative route is via: Eastbound - Barrack Street, Ketts Hill, Bishop Bridge Road, Riverside Road, Riverside, Koblenz Avenue, Carrow Road, King Street, Bracondale, Queens Road, St Stephens Roundabout, Chapel Field Road, Grapes Hill, Barn Road, St Cripsins Road. Westbound - St Cripsins Road, Barn Road, Grapes Hill, Chapel Field Road, St Stephens Roundabout, Queens Road, Bracondale, King Street, Carrow Road, Koblenz Avenue, Riverside, Riverside Road, Bishop Bridge Road, Ketts Hill, Barrack Street.

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Norfolk County Council.

The closure/restriction is necessary or expedient because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the Roads A and B.

The closure/restriction is anticipated to take place from 19:00 on the 11th to 05:00 on the 12th September 2026 but the Roads A and B may continue to be closed/restricted until the 15th September 2026 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

This Notice shall be in effect from 11th to 15th September 2026 or until the closure/restriction is no longer necessary, whichever is the earliest.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure/restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 15th September 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by an Order.

Any existing restrictions or prohibitions within Orders made under the RTRA 1984 will become suspended where they conflict with the provisions of this Notice during the operation of this Notice.

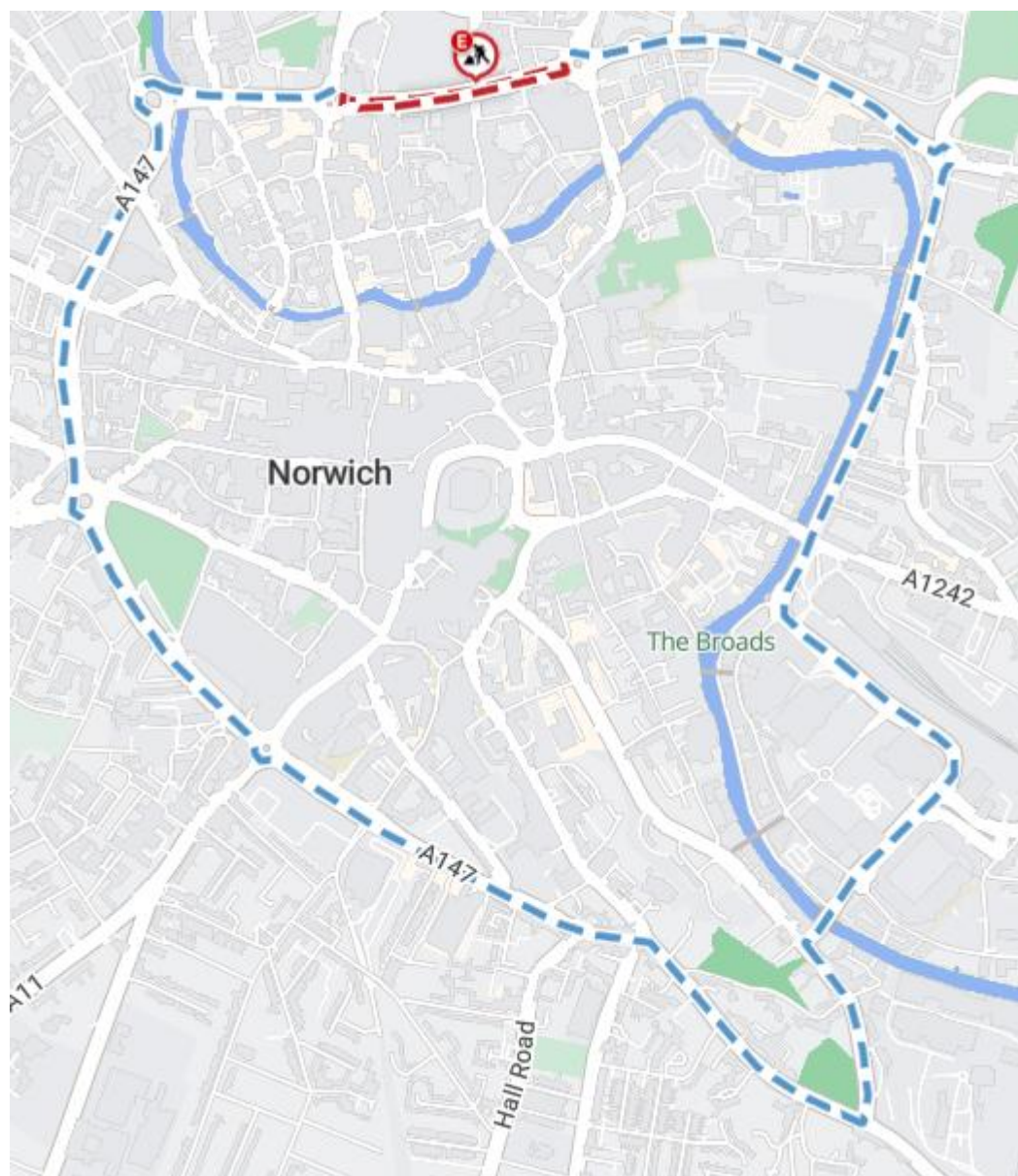
A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/ closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
