Emergency Notice
Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026
Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Norwich, Surrey Street (8473-6856-9150-3285) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to an electrical fault the use by vehicles (of any class) of Surrey Street Footway (south side of carriageway only) from 15 metres northwest of its junction with Queens Road for 30 metres north-westwards (the "Footway") and Surrey Street (north side of carriageway only) from 21 metres northwest of its junction with Queens Road for 27 metres north-westwards (the "Road") in the City of Norwich. The Footway will be temporarily closed/restricted, and traffic (constituting any class of vehicle) over the Road shall be temporarily prohibited to park, stop, load, and/or unload for the duration of the works/period the restriction is necessary.

Alternative route is via: Queens Road, All Saints Green, Surrey Street and vice versa.

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: UK Power Networks.

The closure/restriction is necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public or serious damage to the Road or both.

The closure/restriction is anticipated to take place from 8th to 15th September 2026, but the Road may continue to be closed/restricted until the 28th September 2026 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works / when the closure/restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 28th September 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for an additional 21 days by further Notice and/or for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by further Order.

Any existing restrictions or prohibitions within Orders made under the RTRA 1984 will become suspended where they conflict with the provisions of this Notice during the operation of this Notice.

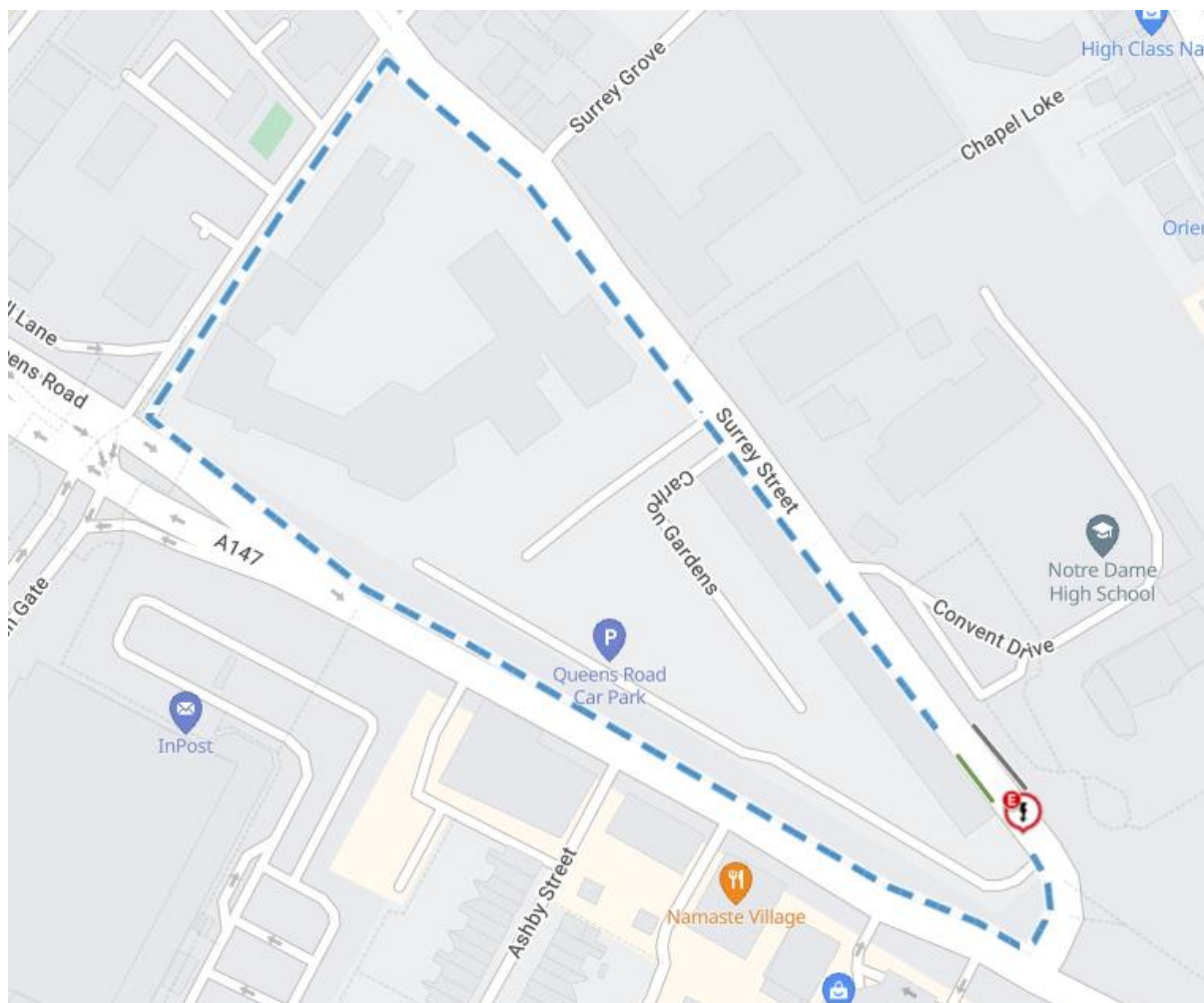
A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/ closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
